DECLARATION FOR WIDOW'S PENSION.

Act of April 19, 1908,

Amended by Act of September 8, 1916.

STATE OF Virginia COUNTY OF Lanier

On this 18th day of December, 1916, personally appeared before me, a Notary Public within and for the County and State aforesaid, Mrs. Ellen Rose who, being duly sworn by me according to law, declares that she is 76 years of age and that she was born Nov 8th, 1840 at Albany New York

That she is the widow of Archabald Rose, who enlisted Sept 21st 1864 at St-Paul Minn, under the name of Archabald Rose as a Private in Co G 9th Regt Minn Vol Infy (Rank.)

and was honorably discharged July 23, 1865 having served ninety days or more during the Civil War.

That he also served _____ (Here give a complete statement of all other military, naval, or coast guard service, if any, at whatever time rendered.)

That otherwise than as herein stated said soldier (or sailor) was not employed in the United States service.

That she was married to said soldier (or sailor) Sept-9th, 1863 under the name of Ellen Austin at Red Wing Minn by Frank Dyer; that she had not been previously married; that he had been previously married, to one Esten Stephens who died at Red Wing Minn in 1861 (Here state all prior marriages of either, and give the names and dates and places of death or divorce of all former consorts.)

and that neither she nor said soldier (or sailor) was ever married otherwise than as stated above.

That said soldier (or sailor) died Dec. 11th, 1916, at Sawtell 570 home Calif that she was not divorced from him; and that she has not remarried since his death.

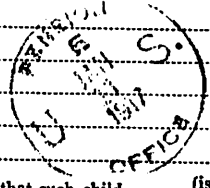
