That he knows that said Rose was not troubled with the rheumatism but was a healthy vigorous man, capable of and doing hard manual labor on a farm. That deponent was in the hospital in Donnell's Bluff, Arkansas, with said Rose and knows that said Rose was suffering from rheumatism and scurvy contracted while in the service. That since said Rose's discharge from service he has been suffering with rheumatism and the same has been, as he grows older, getting worse and is such that said Rose is unable to do hard manual labor and has not done hard work for some years past, and in my opinion is wholly unable by reason of rheumatism

he further declare that he has no interest in said claim.
