Physician's Affidavit.

In the matter of the application of Archibald Rose, aged 80 years, late private in company C 3rd regiment Minnesota Infantry Volunteers, in the Civil War, On this 5th day of June, A.D. 1913, personally appeared before me, a Notary Public, within and for the County and State aforesaid, duly qualified to administer oaths, Dr. W.N. De Armond, aged 49 years, a resident of Fort Collins, Colorado, -who being by me duly sworn according to law, declares in relation to the aforesaid claim, as follows:-- I am a regular practicing physician, and have examined the said Archibald Rose, and find him to be suffering from arterial sclerosis, produced partially by old age, aggravated by rheumatic affection, which has caused what is called a "rheumatic" (irregular) heart, which incapacitates him from performing any manual labor. His heart-condition indicates that his rheumatic affection has been of long standing, and is permanent.
