# General Affidavit.

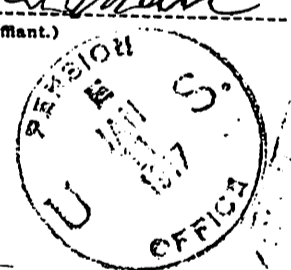

Personally came before me, a Notary Public in and for  
aforesaid County and State, Charles Boatman aged 73 years,  
residing at Red Wing, County of Goodhue, State of  
Minn., who, being duly sworn, declares:

That he knew Ellen Rose in her girlhood. her maiden name was  
Ellen Sulter and he knows positively from personal recollection  
that her marriage to Archibald Rose was her first and only  
marriage. He also knew Archibald Rose when he was married to his  
first wife Esther and remembers her death and knows that Archibald  
Rose was not married after the death of Esther until he married  
Ellen Sulter about a year later, both events taking place during  
the war time.
