duty except the lightest kind when
the Regt left Batesville he was left
behind on account of such sickness
he being unable to travel he was a
sound man when he joined the Regt
but was not fit for duty when dis-
charged I know from my own
personal knowledge he contracted
he contracted said sickness while
in line of duty and that he was
almost wholly disabled by it. My
name being Captain in and
being present at the time is how
I am cognizant of above state of facts.
