

NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATION CENTRE BRANTFORD SOUTHERN ACCESS ROAD

The City of Brantford is carrying out an Environmental Planning Study for the Brantford Southern Access Road. This roadway is proposed as an arterial running southerly and easterly from Colborne Street West, in the vicinity of Oak Hill Drive, across the Grand River to Park Road North at Colborne Street East. At this point, the alignment turns and runs northerly along or adjacent to Park Road North to the project limits at Power Line Road. The anticipated works will include intersection improvements at all applicable locations.

The Study is being undertaken in accordance with the requirements of the Class Environmental Assessment for Municipal Road Projects. Upon completion of the study, an Environmental Study Report will be available for public viewing. A further public notice will be published at that time.

We are interested in hearing any comments or concerns you or your group may have about this project. In order to familiarize you with the study and to provide the opportunity to discuss your concerns with the Project Team, PUBLIC INFORMATION CENTRES will be held as follows at the Brantford Civic Centre Auditorium, Market Street South, Brantford:

If you believe after consulting with the Project Team, that serious environmental concerns remain unresolved, it is your right to request that the project be subject to a formal Environmental Assessment review and approval process, possibly including a formal public hearing. The decision on your request rests with the Minister of the Environment.

Comments and information regarding this Study are being collected to assist the City of Brantford in meeting the requirements under the Environmental Assessment Act. Your comments will be maintained as a public data base and will be kept on file for use during the study and unless otherwise requested, may be included in study documentation which is made available for public review.

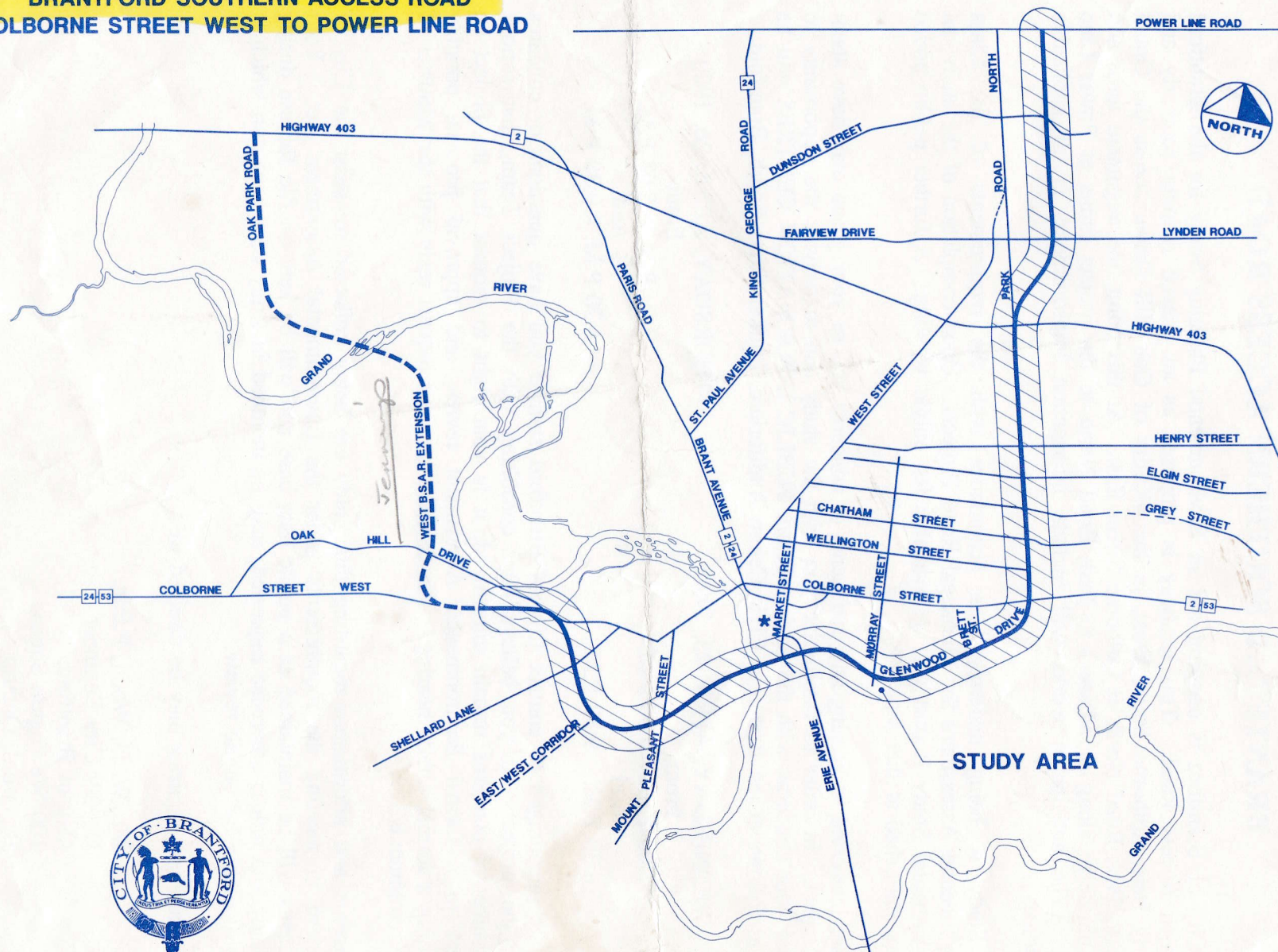
