Shelter Operations:

- Jenny and Becca's meeting with Mendocino CEO was rescheduled to 8/23/24. Having open dialect surrounding current needs.
- More than typical, things are challenging for HSIMC.
- Hearing "through the grapevine" that HSIMC is taking over County Shelter.
 - o HSIMC is not taking over the contract.
 - o John reached out to Glenn McGourty for further comment. No word yet. The county board has not convened in two months.
- Propane tank for fireplace to be utilized for future generator.
- Mini Splits complete in Dean's Cat House. Fund the need next year: generator?
- Front gate will be switched out, posts will be added, arms will be added, ASAP for \$50.00.
- Fencing needs repairs in gauntlet. Community service workers may be able to help with this.
- Intake and Surrender policy: does not state that we will always take our animals back should surrender occur. HSIMC cannot help as much as we would like in our current circumstances. The same goes for intake on stray animals. For now, our amazing Fosters are helping and HSIMC is providing food in these circumstances.



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Finance:

July activity \$37.3K income / \$45.0k expenses

Bank account \$20.5k checking / \$86.0k in reserve

YTD \$307.8k income / \$374.5k expenses (\$66.7k unfavorable, anticipated \$35.5k unfavorable)

LPL account \$1,087.5k / \$4,655 monthly dividend payment

Since June the balance in our general reserve is now \$40.2k, \$33k from payroll, \$8k to go back in with membership, sponsorship, and cash-flow. Community Foundation Grant to help offset expenses (Minimum of 80k to receive). Need to get creative with fundraising activities.

Fundraisers:

Continuing to look for a new chairperson. Should we drop this down to 5-10 hours per week and take more of the responsibility on as a board?

New/Exciting fundraisers: Doggy wedding? Battle of the Bands? Music for Mutts? Children's book about the shelter?

2025 Calendar project: Design is complete. Looking for corporate sponsors: SpareTime will sponsor. Wynona will ask the leadership class at Ukiah High School to help sell them again. They may be ready in time to sell for Kritter Karnival. Cost \$5-\$6, selling for \$20.00. 60 calendars sold=recoup costs. Will ask other resources if they would be willing to sell: Senior Center? Downtown Dogs and East Hill? Fire department?

Appreciation Event: A very nice event. Would have liked to see more people attend. Suggestions: needed more flyers, posters, and posts surrounding this event. Too long? Wrong time of day? More places to put-up flyers added to the spreadsheet.
