Shelter Director – Community foundation will be providing another grant in September. Not sure what the amount will be.

Security cameras set up to try and capture people who are dumping animals.

East Hills impact – Cut our S/N capacity to two weeks per month. With analysis of utilizing other vets (even if they have the capacity) would cost us an add'l \$50k per year. Several changes expected within the county animal control organization.

Fundraising – Appreciation event feedback was very good – approx. 55 people signed in.
