Shelter Stats:

July 2023 Intakes:

67 animals

29 dogs of those 5 strays 20 owner surrenders 4 transfers 10 other

38 cats of those 22 strays 2 owner surrenders 14 other

July 2023 Outcomes:

76 animals

34 dogs of those 33 adoptions 1 return to owner 0 other outcomes

42 cats of those 37 adoptions 5 other outcomes

2 of the 4 dogs just transferred from animal control have already been adopted.

Looking at long term animals that have been adopted. Some longterm adoptions need to celebrated! Need to figure out how to do that without skewing the data.

Shelter Director Updates:

Social Media for business sponsors – Have 3 signs up. Trying to encouraging other businesses to sign up. Still have not received check back from Alliance Auto Repair. Joe Hurlbut is retiring next year and hopes that Beckstoffer will continue to be a business sponsor. Sparetime Supply has asked for an honorary business partnership based on the donation of the large container and support of many fundraising events. All agreed to move forward with the request. Jenny to provide John with high-res logo to create signage.

CART – Community Animal Response Team – assist in emergency situations.

We've been communicating with them to have them come and work with us to interact with the public. They will bring a conex container to our facility. It will be placed near the front gate and will provide additional food to share with people needing assistance. Their staff will man the space.

A staff member is leaving the shelter so we're looking at reorganizing. 150 cats currently in care. Hoping to keep it closer to 100.

Calendar contest –5 businesses have confirmed sponsorship ads / 4 others interested. Current funds at \$9K.

East Hill is working to get us back on our weekly schedule for spay and neuter. She is currently fitting us in with occasional twice weekly appointments.

Community Foundation – hoping to see a payout in September. Don't know the amount.

Several thank you's from the community that we've been able to help them with options of resources. Good customer service. We had a discussion about adding other types of animals on the rehoming page.

Fundraising:

Mendocino Barkery adoption event will be August 26th from 10am – 1pm to coincide with the farmers market. Looking at having cats inside the store. We need more volunteers.

Kritter Karnival will be held on Sunday, October 8th from 12pm to 4pm.

Lengthy discussion about roles and responsibilities for KK (see attached)!

Need the whole board to help and support the event.

Pumpkin Patch (Jack & Noel's holiday garden) HSIMC will have a tabletop on Saturday, October 14 from 12pm – 3pm. Maybe hot chocolate and/or hot cider and popcorn machine.

Pints for Pups – Hopland Tap on September 9th from 2pm – 5pm

Need volunteers.

Elizabeth has made contact with the Elks for HSIMC presentation. Their meetings are on Friday's at 6pm at the Elks lodge. They normally have 20-30 ppl attend. She will provide John with contact information to set up a date / time to present.

Construction:

Will begin to install new siding on the barn soon.

AC unit has been installed and is operational. Still need to get the doggie doors completed to conserve AC and heating.

Electrical – 8/28 – PG&E coming to connect power to the new panels. Power will be out at the shelter all day.

Drainage – Pardini's quote was \$8,200. Too much.

Maybe CCC could help with either digging or sandbags.

Tracey has volunteered to update the outside signage near Uva Dr. JK would like to add something about Beatrice Breese donating the property.

Jack Hill Estate. Working with new legal support. Flipper has been put on hold. Sandra Elle must resign as trustee and need to define new EIN.

Elizabeth suggesting that we confirm any insurance requirements.
