- Care-A-Van vet got hurt. We are on their schedule for October.
- Jenny: We had a cat foster volunteer during covid who was working to get cats into foster. Emily is now working on that with good success.

Update from Admin Dir: Jenny:

- Still working on FB donation issue. GuideStar says there is no problem.
 Hoping for response from FB this week. In spite of that, we received \$15K in online donations! Much of that effort has been in response to FB posts by Becca, Emily and Junanne. Thanks, ladies!
- AT&T monthly billing is approx. \$150/mo for phone and internet. They've now partnered with Lingo which is offering the same service for \$120/mo.
- MCSB has a \$1,640 donation for HSIMC. They will be coming to the shelter on Wednesday to present and photo op. Both companies will share info on their website.
- Ukiah Natural Foods Co-op has accepted our application for "round up".
