MEDICAL

Oliver Styx comes back from foster with labored breathing. After emergency care from Wasson and further diagnostics with East Hill Vet he was diagnosed with heart failure.

Bear was showing signs and symptoms of parvo, his owners surrendered so HSIMC could provide emergency medical care and prevent other unvaccinated puppies in the home from being further exposed. Bear was vomiting, had bloody diarrhea, and was lethargic. Wasson provided emergency care and by the next morning Bear was showing improvement. He's now hanging in a foster home and being a puppy!

Shelter Operations Wins/Challenges

CHALLENGES

- ★ Halted all non urgent intakes due to insufficient funds and capacity for care (spay/neuter surgeries booked)
- ★ High volume of community calls looking for assistance with pet food
- ★ Feral cat onsite found with two, 8 week old kittens

WINS

- ★ Board Member Tracey takes initiative to build our Membership program by distributing Newsletters with Membership Sign Up sheets at our local libraries.
- ★ Animals are now listed on Adopt-A-Pet - a platform similar to PetFinder, helping our animals be seen.
- ★ Kitten College was a success! We had 24 participants and this kudo from both representatives of Kitten College Maddie's Fund. "We are so impressed by what you're doing there and your dedication to process improvement. HSIMC is unlike any facility we have ever seen"
- ★ New! E-Cards added to website
- ★ End of Summer Adoption Event Adoptions: 11 Dogs, 25 Cats

FUTURE

- We are continuing to work with Marnie and her team to bring the Kitten College program to HSIMC!
- ★ Further development of the website to add more resources for our community
- ★ Community Service Handbook underway
- Jenny & Becca will be representing HSIMC at Clearlake Animal Associations clinic in Lake County in October - gaining insight and knowledge into community clinics
