- BoD birthday fundraisers Discussed opportunity for board members to open birthday fundraisers on FB to increase donations
- Grant submitted to ASPCA Waiting for December decision
- Vegan/Vegetarian Menu Options for HSIMC Events~ Jenny
 - Discussion regarding large rescues converting to vegetarian / vegan menus for events. Recognized that many of those rescues come from large cities vs. rural communities and probably wouldn't be well received here in Redwood Valley. But will continue to provide veggie options at events.

Shelter Operations Report – Becca/Jenny

- Lets of changes going on at shelter. Medical techs can begin wearing scrubs. Cross training between the cat and dog teams.
- 3 long term cats and two long term dogs were adopted in October.
- Jenny looking into more efficient and healthy structures for inside the cat intake shed. Putting together a proposal to present to two of our long time cat donors.
- Jenny and Becca participated in the Jamison Humane free vaccine, microchip and wellness clinic in Lake County. Amazed at the number of people who need this service. Would like to work with MCAC to offer the same in Mendocino County. Kether would like to see materials costs for vaccines and microchipping. Becca said she hoped for a grant that would cover all costs.
- Big kudos for a well written and informative report.

October financials – John – YTD income - \$498.6K / expenses - \$517K with deficit operating budget of \$18.4K, but that includes the \$80K from Community Foundation for spay / neuter services. Due to low donations this year, we've had to pull \$53K from our reserve account to pay bills. Jenny has been doing an amazing job at trying to balance payments, but the reserve account is down to about \$20K, which means we may need to start pulling from our investment account, which we do NOT want to do.

Jenny to continue to revise 2025 budget. Will send out prior to December board meeting to review and we will vote on accepting it at Dec. BoD Meeting.
