MEDICAL

- ★ Nalah- Senior cat who struggled in the shelter environment with extreme FAS and vomiting resulting in emergency vet care. Turns out a foster home was the cure! Nalah is doing great now and is ready for adoption!
- ★ Asha post spay infection requires a hospital visit
- ★ Senior dogs Tubby and Auggie are diagnosed with heartworm and anaplasma, their treatments begins at EVH soon
