Bank account \$17.5k checking / \$78.0k in reserve

YTD \$307.8k income / \$374.5k expenses \$66.7k unfavorable, (Original budget anticipated \$35.5k unfavorable) LPL account \$1,101.5k / \$4,655 monthly dividend payment

Hopefully the Community Foundation Grant will help offset expenses (Minimum of 80k to receive). Need to get creative with fundraising activities.

## **Construction Projects:**

**Update from Tracey:** On a Sunday soon, we will need to repair 2 safety concerns prior to returning to the extension on the barn:

- 1. The electrical wire that drops into the office and dog barn is an undersized wire. Should be replaced immediately and could be the reason for the breaker overloading. Cora and Alex will be able to repair this for around \$300-\$400. There are a total of 3 wires needing to be replaced, one is a ground. Please do not leave things running and overload the breaker. This will be fixed immediately as it is a fire hazard.
- 2. The BAS roofing is hanging by a thread and may collapse with snow falling on it or people walking on it. It is not safe to walk on. The plan will be to add stud walls to the north wall, south wall, and 1 interior wall.

### Status for front sign:

It is painted and drawn out, ready for the next stage.

## Status balance on Fund the Need:

\$27,000 remains in the Fund the Need and we will be fixing the immediate safety concerns first.
