# Shelter Operations Wins/Challenges

#### **CHALLENGES**

- ★ Losing El Fonzo to parvo was a tragic event for our staff and community after we all tried so hard to save him
- ★ No spay and neuter surgery availability for the month of November
- ★ Getting supplies out to the community where it's needed most
- ★ Weather!!! We experienced a week of heavy rains and cold temps which is a challenge for our dog team, once again fosters came to our rescue!
- ★ Day old puppies found in the bushes with their mom, Reba, freezing temps at night making this an emergency
- ★ Sharing shed space for winter fundraiser

#### **WINS**

- ★ Longest resident, Dugan, finds his forever home!
- ★ HSIMC raised over \$1,800 and collects human food supplies for the UC Davis spay/neuter clinic in Covelo
- ★ Jessica Storm of SCPR 2nd Chance Cat Sanctuary is taking care of multiple stray cat colonies and has been able to utilize HSIMC's current overstock of beds, bedding, blankets, litter, and litter bags.
- Home for the Holidays Adoption Special: 11 cats and 2 dogs eligible for the special during 11/13-11/24.
- ★ Dog team has managed to keep all dogs inside every night this winter, with access to heat
- ★ Nimble, a cat who escaped during surrender, was trapped in our culvert! She is now safe inside, fixed and on her pathway to adoption

#### **FUTURE**

- ★ Christmas adoption special coming up next month!
- ★ Jenny, Becca, and Suzanne are considering joining the next UC Davis clinic in Covelo in Spring 2025
- ★ HSIMC's Leadership Team is working on additional ways to provide services to the community.
- ★ Q4 staff training will start in December and be focused on Compassion Fatigue and Burnout"In it for the long haul" by Hilary
