STAFFING

- ★ 10 Employees (7 FT, 3 PT)
- ★ Emily and Rae receive training and are now equipped to administer, record and schedule all core vaccines and standard intake treatments
- ★ Rae and Becca complete "Adoption Counseling" course thanks to Maddies University
- ★ All animal care staff complete PPE training through Austin Pets Alive Shelter Essentials
- ★ Becca completed Essentials of Working with People through Austin Pets Alive Shelter Essentials Course
- ★ Rae currently enrolled in Trish McMillion Shelter Behavior course. We asked her how things are going, "I have many new ideas to bring on board and this course is solidifying the methods on behavior I have learned here at HSIMC."

MEDICAL

- ★ Firefly receives emergency c-section and hernia repairs after being found in critical condition with multiple dead kittens stuck inside of her. She is not out of the woods yet, currently in care of a medical foster, Erin Maverick
- ★ Awnie- named by Dr. Chana after "grass awn" due to the hundreds of foxtails that were removed from this 7 pound little dog, this was one of the worst foxtail cases our vet has ever seen
- ★ Febris, kitten who came to us with calicivirus, was unable to recover from her eye ulcers, received right eye enucleation on 7/2
- ★ On 7/28 a 4 week old kitten died in our care, this kitten was surrendered showing severe signs of Calicivirus. His brother, Umber, survived and is doing well in his foster home

Shelter Operations Wins/Challenges

CHALLENGES

- ★ Cat abandoned at our facility on 7/17
- ★ Power outage on 7/18 and 7/23 puts staff in the dark for a few hours!
- ★ Clarifying our return and owner surrender policy to the public and stakeholders. Group discussion at board meeting with Becca
- ★ Very low cash flow, making payroll and AP very challenging and tapping the reserve account has become necessary.
- ★ Four puppies abandoned in a tub at Grace Hudson School, finder was told to leave the where they found them by other organization, luckily an HSIMC foster home opened up so we could save them!

<u>WINS</u>

- ★ Expo in action! We utilized our first Community Service worker, Brenda, for dog walking!
- ★ Long term resident dog, Duffy, finds a foster to adopt home after 500 days at our shelter! We all have our paws crossed that it will work out!
- ★ Volunteers Danielle Ault (adoption updates) and Myriah Surman (volunteer orientation reminders) have provided consistent social media support in their focus areas which has been a huge help this year!
- ★ Jenny saves the shelter approx. \$4,000 per year on newsletter printing!
- ★ Cat living in our shed for the last 4 weeks is finally trapped!

FUTURE

- ★ Kitten College is coming to HSIMC on September 15th! All are welcome to attend the community portion!
- ★ New Shelter Luv coming soon! Shelter Luv, our shelter software is rolling out new updates- we are excited!
- ★ Three upcoming MCACS surgery days scheduled in August! Total of 79 spay/neuters will be completed
- ★ End of Summer Adoption Event coming in August 28th -September 21st! All spayed/neutered dogs \$50 and cats \$25. Seniors and long term residents (3+ months) FREE!!
- ★ Preparing for the changing season, colder weather is coming
