## Shelter Operations Wins/Challenges

#### **CHALLENGES**

- ★ LOS continues to rise for all dogs over 40 pounds
- ★ Dog kennels at capacity with only 50 dogs in care
- ★ Two rattlesnakes found on property!
- ★ Cat spay/neuter surgeries for cats currently in our care, are scheduled out into December, putting a halt on cat intakes until we can get caught up.

#### WINS

- ★ Adopt-A-Pet Day on June 1st was a success! We started our month with 3 dogs and 6 cats getting adopted but 6 dogs and 14 cats went home that day!
- ★ Cat surrender applications added to our website for easy access to our community
- Devan Amundsen onsite 6/8 & 6/30 to provide outside education opportunities to our team and community
- Feedback from our community: they are so thankful that we are here to provide counseling and support them even when we can't always take an animal. The empathy and compassion from our team is appreciated!

#### <u>FUTURE</u>

- ★ Kitten College onsite workshop coming in August, will need to raise \$1,500 for travel costs.
- Survive!
- ★ Care A Van day in the works with Dr. Burns, date is TBA
- ★ Work on and complete existing projects before brining on new ones.
