### Public Forum - Guest Introduction & comments

#### President's Comments - Teresa

- Really appreciate all the participation for the Kritter Karnival and Texas Hold'em! Great turnout, amazing events! And the weather cooperated for Kritter Karnival!
- Thank you everyone for providing input on the Kritter Karnival wrap-up feedback document and conversations!

- Thank you, Kelsey, for taking the minutes in Erin's absence!

### Financial Update Report - John

- Sept: revenue \$44,300 expenses \$49,200, operating loss of just under \$5,000
- YTD income \$438,500, expenses \$468,200, operating loss of \$29,700

### **Shelter Operations Report** – Becca/Jenny

- Did a lot in September!
- Jenny shared that we received a portion of an estate. Greatly appreciated!
- Jenny has started a proposal for use of the new monies, in draft form currently, she will share out for board review.
  - Some proposed projects include: solar (will likely be approx. \$300,000 including infrastructure John), free dog trainers, funding the reserve account, etc.
  - o John advocated for beefing up the investment account.
  - Lots to discuss, GREAT NEWS!
  - o Simple money investment account could mean about 5% John suggestion
  - Community Foundation will be delivering checks Oct/Nov when they complete their wrap-up.
     Was ~\$80k in past, might be more this round, as they are seeing the benefit HSIMC provides to the community.

### **Construction Projects – Tracey**

- Planning the Rainbow Bridge, exciting project! Mostly using donated lumber/materials. Exciting
  because it's not a desperate need, more of a passion/fun project. It could also become a fundraiser
  (people could add their collars etc. to the bridge). It will also actually be used, hopefully will become a
  cool attraction. Open to ideas as this project progresses. 12' long, working out the details
- Working on the inside wall
- Working on expanding the barn

## Fundraising Activities – Kelsey

#### Kritter Karnival

- o Amazing Event, and we are famous! Front page in Willits Weekly.
  - Final intake not complete, but approximately \$4,000
- Should we vote on whether to split back or keep as combined event? Seems most people support keeping it combined.
- There was a lot of extra food. In the future perhaps we could plan ahead to donate any leftovers to: PlowShares, Meals on Wheels, Building Bridges, Senior Center
- Emphasis on ensuring strong communication with vendors/community volunteers prior to the event
- John proposes we do something to thank Mary and her team, as they have held the food at KK strong for years and years, donate food, handle logistics.
- Please be mindful of language we are using in any notes we are sending out to larger community
- o Is the dunk tank worth it in the future for the cost? Let's investigate other potential activities.

#### Willits Harvest Moon

- o Fun event, great connecting with people in community
- Approx. \$100 in swag + donations
- o It is worth it to have a HSIMC presence and was tons of fun!
- o Maybe we could have some sort of engaging activity at the table next time?

#### Texas Hold' em

- o It was awesome!
- Challenges: held the same night as multiple events in Willits (cooking contest, rodeo, homecoming etc.)
- Had approx. 25 players, many re-upped
- Volunteers were great, had tons of us, had a great time! Appreciation was expressed for everybody.
- We were able to wrap up earlier than anticipated due to smaller number of participants and an efficient clean-up crew.
- Players who lost early stayed and held their own cash game, donated \$5/per pot to HSIMC
- Netted approx. \$4,000
- Let's do this annually, continue to work on marketing, suggested locations for fliers barber shops, gyms, bars, mechanic shops. Add radio ad and maybe video at Noyo theater.
- Tacos were great, fresh
- o Barely sold wine, mostly sold beer. North Spur beer ran out, cheap beer was popular, Coors!
- Maybe don't do pre-registration next time, not many people did and there was some confusion noted that people may have thought you could not register at the door
- o Let's look at timing and larger community calendar when we plan the date next round
- o Dealers were amazing, big kudos to Kether and Erin!
- Good vibes all around
- Simplify the flyers
- o Possibly later in October, November, Winter? Spring? Let's keep strategizing the next date.

- Teresa got a request from Spears Transportation, who would like to host an adoption event.
  - Teresa is following up.

- Teresa got a call from Michael Woskow interested in doing a firewood raffle fundraiser.
  - Teresa will follow up with Jenny on this.
- Adoption Events We have capacity for one per month.
  - o Jenny is delegating coordination to Fundraising/volunteer leads
  - We need Chairs for these events.

- Wrapping Paper Fundraiser Joe is Chair
  - Will need at least 2 people per wrapping event

  - Joe is in process of reaching out to potential places

    - Pink Friday around Thanksgiving
    - Recommendations to contact for table space:

      - Larger Retail stores? Kohls, Costco, Tractor Supply, Hobby Lobby,
  - Need: tape, ribbons, gift tags, scissors
  - Lets price "by donation" for wrapping, sizes will vary
  - \$3 per sheet for purchase of wrapping paper "to-go"
- NorthSpur Brewery Customized beer and label Ronnie / Kelsey
- Event Marketing and New Potential Event Brainstorm:
  - o Please get flyers etc. at least 2 weeks prior to events
  - o Creating both social media format and print out format for flyers is helpful!
  - Joe has connection for a possible HSIMC promo video (Vince Martinez)
    - \$100 for promo video
    - Has a connection with Noyo Theater in Willits (Logan?) looking for advertisement to play at beginning of movies playing at the theater – varied pricing depending how long they play the add, may have non-profit rate. 15-30 second advertisements

- This could be a helpful strategy to engage new members and sponsors. Especially if we could update with specific events each month, could we add a QR code? Theater sells approx. 25,000 movie tickets per year.
- Contact at Novo Theater is Logan (we think?)
- Tracey will sponsor \$500 for running the ad. Who can match or support fundraising for this?
- Another idea: movie night idea fundraiser at the theater, or outdoors with a projector
- Wreath Fundraiser coming right up! Cindy
  - TNT Orientation dates: Saturday Nov 15<sup>th</sup>; Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> 12-1pm Cindy
  - Looking for 32 gallon upright containers donations for greenery
  - Cindy is reaching out for supply donations and volunteers
  - Teresa bought 2 rolls of wire ribbon
  - Wreath rings have been delivered (200)
  - Let's get marketing and flyers going asap, would be great to have flyers at upcoming events
  - Discussion Should we increase the pricing by \$5 per item? (decided to keep same prices)
    - There has been no price increase in the last few years
    - Keeping at \$50/wreath, \$40/swag
    - Feedback:
      - Not much cost associated with the materials, we might want to keep it as is.
         Let's compare with similar fundraisers, cost analysis
      - Raising a little bit is reasonable.
      - Let's give the gift of keeping the price as is.
      - We don't know the reason there was a drop in sales last year pricing? Less days of the event.
      - \$5 increase could be significant for people.
      - Cost: \$400 for the wires that is the only expense
    - Julie Golden requested to be the first order, she typically orders a lot to display at local businesses. Yes! (Jenny will connect with Cindy on this)
    - We do not want to accept used wreath rings, they don't work to reuse
- Calendars
  - Design is complete, ready to order
  - We don't typically sell out
  - o Pricing is staggered depending on how many we order
  - John suggested asking if we can we get 150 at the price for 100?
- We are not registering for the light parade this year
