Approval of Agenda:

- \$13.6k / \$48.2k expenses
- Bank account \$34.6k checking / \$31.0k in reserve
- LPL account \$1109k + \$2k / \$4,655 monthly dividend payment
- Average expense per day: \$1761 /Revenue per day: \$1604 (+ \$157 per day)
- We need \$52k-\$54k per month to break even
- Bank= 20 days of spend & Reserve = 18 days.
- Approximately \$5k in fund raising expense \$3.4 swag + Misc

Shelter Operations: July's Board Report has been emailed to all board members and uploaded to HSIMC website.

- Our behavior euthanasia policy is to opt in for details, just let Becca know you are interested. This way only those who wish to know will know as it is sensitive information that can be difficult for some to see/learn about.
- Cremations are expensive and we cannot bury onsite. Memorial? Dogwood tree? Rainbow bridge? Plaques?

• New Fundraising Planning Sheet: Continuing to make edits but is usable. Suggested add space for hours of fundraising event and spot for board approved budget.

- Vibes and Vines at Mia Bea (June 29): Very good event, sold out! Mia Bea would like to do more events but does not want to be so involved in the planning. HSIMC will do more of the planning moving forward. We need paper tickets as that went well. Consider selling paper tickets at "Sundays in the Park" next year. Debrief was fun and we were able to support Flying Dog Pizza after they have done so much for us. We will need more people to set up and break down next year.
- **Doggonit event:** Cloverdale with Glory at Doggonit. Kyla Iverson to lead. September 20th decided as date. Kyla will offer nail trims and donate proceeds to HSIMC. She will do the trimming with a suggested minimum donation. Glory will provide free bags with items for adopted animals. We will need tabletop, swag, volunteers, and dogs.
