

Chmielewski or to otherwise engage in other unlawful sexual conduct with a child or another person believed to be a child, contrary to Section 847.0135(4)(a), Florida Statutes.

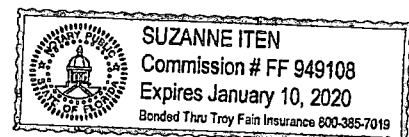
