This class teaches you the meaning of the Medicine Wheel and how to work with it, as well as provides you with time at the end of class for some personal quiet meditation or reflection. Many cultures respect the Sacred Hoop, the Circle of Life, and the sacred spiritual teachings that accompany a Medicine Wheel. This Wheel is a respectful combination of several cultures. The Medicine Wheel teaches, provides insight, supports healing of body, mind and spirit, helps us find inner peace, guides us as we search for our path and purpose, and provides the wisdom we need to journey through life. Each section of the wheel represents a direction, a color, an animal teaching, a time of day, a stage of life, plant medicine, life lessons, and more.



SATURDAY, JULY 4th 10am—12noon Class Limit: 15 "Creative Spirit" Arts & Crafts Series Staining Concrete Statuary \$25 (Plus concrete item)

Sometimes we just need to give our minds a break and enjoy the thing that is sitting right in front of us. Being mindful in our present moment can be very healing. In this Creative Spirit class, we allow ourselves to be creative with no self-judgement and we take pleasure in the creative process. At White Barn we feel that creativity, self-expression, calmness of mind, peace of spirit, can be found through art. Class instructor, Annette Bragg, has several art degrees from the University of Akron, a strong work history and art background having owned an advertising agency, and is a firm believer in art therapy. This class is fun, relaxing, creative, and will allow yourself to enjoy staining and painting safely in the wonderful outdoor setting at White Barn. You can purchase a concrete item of your choice when you arrive, with a great assortment of pieces to choose from. Many prices average from about \$18 to \$65—something to fit every budget.



SUNDAY, JULY 5th 7pm—9pm Class Limit: 1 Spirit Arrow Ceremony Releasing Burdens and Trauma from our Past \$25

Don't ever let the word "ceremony" in the title of any classes or experiences at White Barn discourage you from attending. Ceremonies are common in our culture to celebrate milestones—weddings, baptisms, graduations, funerals, and many other important life events. The Spirit Arrow Ceremony is designed to help us release burdens that we tend to carry, like a big heavy blanket wrapped around our shoulders, that keeps us from being our best selves or living our best life. Burdens we may have difficulty releasing are unforgiveness, abuse, hurt, jealousy, bitterness, resentment and fear. Often we become "stuck" in a story and haven't figured out how to move past it. The Spirit Arrow Ceremony is a very powerful blend of teaching, quiet reflection, changing our perspective on how we view things, and is partly based in sacred indigenous ceremony and teachings. Many people who have found this class to be life-changing in good and positive ways are people dealing with PTSD, addictions, loss, grief and sadness, trauma, abuse, and fear. While it helps each individual to release burdens from the past, it also helps us become aware of our sense of community, and our path and purpose.
