The Dangers of Social Isolation and Loneliness to the Brain and Body

Losing a sense of connection and community changes a person's perception of the world. Someone experiencing chronic loneliness feels threatened and mistrustful of others, which activates a biological defense mechanism, according to Steve Cole, Ph.D. Loneliness acts as a fertilizer for other diseases," Dr. Cole said. "The biology of loneliness can accelerate the buildup of plaque in arteries, help cancer cells grow and spread, and promote inflammation in the brain leading to Alzheimer's disease. Beautiful Cades Cove





Word search puzzles emphasize pattern recognition, a key cognitive tool. Pattern recognition is the brain's ability to find order and create meaning from data around us.
