## **NeighborWorks Great Falls**

Since 1980, NeighborWorks Great Falls has worked to build strong neighborhoods and create successful homeowners through affordable housing, lending, financial education, and neighborhood improvement initiatives. Now, as the organization celebrates its 45th anniversary, it is completing the transformation of the historic Baatz Block Building into 25 units of permanent supportive housing for individuals experiencing homelessness.

The project will provide safe, stable housing along with on-site services such as case management and mental health support to help residents build a new path forward. Tardi Gras 2026 will raise funds to enhance this project and ensure its long-term impact in addressing homelessness in Great Falls.


### What is Permanent Housing and How Does it Impact Out Community

According to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), an estimated 771,480 people were experiencing homelessness on a single night in January 2024. Through this study one-night estimate from January 2024 identified 2,008 people experiencing homelessness in Montana. However, local reports and community organizations state the actual number of people facing housing instability is significantly higher.


Baatz Building, a downtown historic building previously in decay, has been renovated to provide 25 units of Permanent Housing which provides communities with significant cost savings by reducing expensive emergency services, improves health outcomes, increases neighborhood safety, and stimulates local economies by stabilizing property values, consumer spending, and preventing homelessness.

Tardi Gras proceeds will be allocated the Baatz Permanent Housing care of NeighborWorks Great Falls.


