

2023 Terms & Conditions

Registration and Payouts

Shoreline is a prepay [full season] event registration. There is a limit of 40 paid prepaid boats per tournament.

PREPAY:

Boats must prepay for the season and have submitted their signed entry form and payment based on a \$850 tournament season entry fee (see "prepay entry fees" section below). Entries must be postmarked no later than 5/6/23 to be included in the Early Draw for takeoff positions for the season, and to be eligible to earn points and compete for a spot in the Classic. Points will be awarded on the Q65 system (65 points for 1st place, 64 points for 2nd place, etc.). Boats not weighing in but fishing the tournament will receive 0 points towards standings. (Weigh your fish)

Raffle Draw:

Before each one of the qualifiers all teams will have the ability to do a raffle draw for boat position 1 and 2. Should a boat be drawn for one of the positions their previous spot becomes vacant. All entries for the drawing will go towards the classic pot at the end of the year. **ANY** team aside the director boat may enter the raffle drawing.

PRIORITY PREPAY (NEW FOR 2022):

All 2022 members who registered for the full season will be given first opportunity to register for the 2023 season. Entries will be accepted beginning 1/01/23; however, entries for 2022 members postmarked by 4/1/23 will be guaranteed entry for the season (up to 40 paid boats). New boats may send in their registration between 1/01/23 and 5/6/23, but will be placed on a waiting list, in the order in which entries are received, until 5/6/23. After the 4/1/23 postmark priority deadline for 2022 members, all boats who send in their registration form and entry fees will be added to the roster in the order in which the registration was received (whether a new boat or a returning 2022 boat), until 40 entries have been accepted. If we reach 40 boats who prepay and sign up for the full season, registration will end at that time and no additional boats will be accepted.

MEMBERSHIP FEES:

All anglers must pay a one-time annual membership fee of \$40, regardless of prepaying or entering a single tournament. This fee is waived for participants age 15 and younger. Membership fees are used for weigh-in equipment, plaques, insurance, website maintenance, banners, mailers, and other materials to operate the club. The driver must be 18 years or older.

PREPAY ENTRY FEES:

A 2-person boat would pay \$850 for the entire season. A single person boat may have no sub if registered as a single, the total fee is 810.00 includes membership.

Refunds:**Refunds are available up to 5/1/2023**

Should a team or person be disqualified or have their membership revoked they forfeit all entry fees and memberships. Any entries sent in and cancelled prior to 5/1/2023 may get their fees refunded.

Classic:

Eligibility for the Classic will be determined as follows:

If a boat wins any one of the qualifiers for the season, they automatically qualify for the Classic at \$0 entry fee. The top 20% of all teams (which includes individual tournament winners) at the end of the final tournament will also be entered with a waived entry fee.

Example 1, a team wins a tournament and does not qualify as top 20% they still gain entry with no entry fee for winning an event.

Example 2, if a team wins a tournament and finishes in the top 20% that spot still holds and does not pass down.

The tournament director will be invited to the Classic also at \$0 entry fee.

The rest of the qualifying boats may fish the classic by paying a 150.00 entry fee.

Launch order on day one is based on the years total points from highest to lowest.

Launch order day two is based on day one finishers from highest to lowest.

NO subs are allowed in the classic, any team must have fished at least 3 events together to qualify as a team unless specific approval is granted.

NON payout positions:

Parties must be present to win cash and/or prizes at the weigh-ins. If they are not present than the prize will be carried forward to the next tournament.

Memberships:

Shoreline is a closed circuit and holds the right to refuse any teams registration and may decline membership requests at any time. During the season members who reflect negatively either in person on social media may also have their membership removed with no refunds. Sportsmanship is a top priority.
