NOTE TO EDITORS:

Founded in 1944, the **Association of Essex Philatelic Societies** (AEPS) is a non-profit making body that provides a forum for, and mutual assistance to, twenty-two stamp and postal history collecting societies in Essex and neighbouring counties (East London, Hertfordshire and Suffolk), promotes the hobby of philately and holds major "StampEssex" stamp exhibitions in the Spring and Autumn of each year that bring collectors from a wide area into the host town. Please contact the sender for further information on its activities.

Many societies close during the summer months, so the July and August programmes, in particular, are of reduced length.

In philatelic circles, the term "**bourse**" usually means a meeting at which dealers, which may be members with surplus material and/or invited visitors, bring stamps to sell.

The annual "**World Post Day**" (9 October) was established by the United Nations to mark the contribution of, and the anniversary of the founding of, the Universal Postal Union, without which it would be impossible for the modern world to operate.
