HOW TO GET THERE


For latest public transport information, consult <http://traveline.info/>

Train: Nearest station, Chelmsford, has links from London Liverpool Street, Sudbury, Witham, Ipswich, Clacton and (via Shenfield) Southend Victoria and intermediate stations. Distance 2.2. miles.

Bus: Bus services run from Chelmsford Bus Station (Routes 41 and 45) and stop close to the venue (nearest stop: Loftin Way).

Taxi: Taxis are available in Chelmsford.

Car: Exit A12 or A130 at A1060 Maldon Road, heading for Chelmsford. Turn left onto B1009 Beehive Lane. Turn left into Tydemans. Caution: Satellite navigation may not find this turning.
