

## **Teal Colored Halloween Buckets**



This guide to non-candy treats for Halloween isn't about taking a stand against sugar. Not at all is that what it is about! Toothbrushes, apples and floss are still considered lame. This is about giving kids with serious food allergies a chance to feel just like every other trick-or-treater on the special night. The Teal Pumpkin Project (teal is the color of food allergy awareness) started in America in 2014 and is promoted by the Food Allergy Research and Education organization. Every Halloween since 2014, more and more teal pumpkins have popped up around the

country. People place them outside their house to show they have treats other than candy. Kids with allergies carry teal-colored buckets from house to house. There are even teal signs you can buy to let kids know it's OK to ask for a "trinket instead of a treat." If a trick-or-treater carrying a teal pumpkin bucket shows up at your door this Halloween, it means he or she has a food allergy. Consider having a stash of non-food treats like vampire fangs or bouncy balls to hand out. But we know that for all the fun Halloween is for kids, it's just as stressful for parents to pull off. It can be a lot to have two sets of goodies – one candy and one not – to hand out. You can find some simple little treats around town at our dollar stores that would be great for those with allergies. Thank you for helping take care of those with allergies and we hope everyone has a great Halloween!

# TRMC Foundation Donates CPR Devices To Area EMS Operations



The Tift Regional Medical Center Foundation recently presented four Lifeline Arms to Hope EMS, Tift County EMS, and Turner County EMS. These units are designed to perform cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) en route to a hospital, aiding first responders in treating patients. CPR is an emergency lifesaving procedure that is performed when the heart stops beating. Rapid CPR can double or triple the chances of survival after cardiac arrest. With the Lifeline Arm, this device is attached

That mac and cheese tasted just like the mac and cheese I use to get as a child from Morrison's Café in the Albany Mall. Of course, I had to tell my son all about Morrison's Café! We went there many times on Sunday's. The line would stretch out the door but people waited. When you got up to the food bar, you started by telling them what you wanted from the choices in front of you. You could pick from tons of salads, fruit, vegetables, meats and breads. You definitely did not leave that place hungry! Morrison's Cafeterias was a chain of cafeteria-style restaurants, located in the Southeastern United States with a concentration of locations in Georgia and Florida. Generally found in shopping malls, Morrison's primary competition was Piccadilly Cafeterias. It was especially popular in Florida, with its high proportion of retirees. At its peak, the company was a symbol of good Southern cooking and operated 151 restaurants under the Morrison's name in 13 states. Now that is one restaurant that I wished would come back around. What a great lineup of food they had to offer. Do you remember Morrison's Café? Those were the good ole days!


