Our solution	To operate a permanent "Showcase" in Fort Lauderdale, FL the "world's yachting capital" where investment opportunities in NZ are "listed" for presentation to American HNW individuals and families with an interest in diversifying their investment holding asset base through ownership of sanctuary assets / business undertakings in NZ, the world's safest country.
Our Revenue Model	Revenue will be earned from the contracted marketing fee payable upon the closing of a Showcase listed investment.
Our addressable market	London based Henley Partners, the world's largest migration consulting firm forecasts that 128,000 millionaires will move to a new country in 2025. With "Endless Summer" themed marketing targeting HNW American "Baby-Boomers" who resonate to the evocative imagery of this iconic 1996 movie and collective owners of 50% of all personal wealth in the US, estimated at USD84T, a massive addressable market for "Invest-NZ" products.
