- We do not have to do any type of works in order to receive salvation.
- We must do good deeds.
- We must be circumcised.
- We must tithe.
- For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of YHWH: Not of works, lest any man should boast. [Eph 2:8-9](#)
- We must do the works of the Lord. [John 14:12](#)
- We must do the work of an evangelist. [2 Tim 4:5](#)
- We must preach the gospel of “Christ” (יהוֹשֻׁעַ) Jehoshua Hamashiach). [Matt 4:23, Acts 8:25](#)
- We must teach the way of salvation. [Matt 10:7](#)
- We must do the works of faith. [1 Thes 1:3, 2 Thes 1:11](#)
- We must do the works that “Christ” (יהוֹשֻׁעַ) Jehoshua Hamashiach) did and greater. [John 14:12](#)
- If we do not do good works, we deny professing YHWH. [Titus 1:16](#)
- If we do not do good works, we are abominable (detestable) to YHWH. [Titus 1:16](#)

- Faith is made perfect by works. **James 2:22**
- We are justified by faith. **Rom 3:28**

- Baptism doesn't save a person; it's a symbol and celebration of salvation.
- We are buried with "Christ" (יהוֹשֻׁעַ) Jehoshua Hamashiach) in baptism.

Col 2:12

- Baptism also now saves us. **1 Pet 3:21**
- Except we are baptized, we cannot enter the kingdom of YHWH. **John 3:5**

- We are commanded to baptize all nations. **Matt 28:19**
- We are to do only one baptism. **Eph 4:5**
- We are to be baptized with water. **Acts 8:36-38, Acts 22:16, Col 2:12**
- We are to baptize in the name of the Father, Son & of the Holy Ghost.

Matt 28:19

- We are baptized for the remission of our past sins. **Acts 2:38**
- We are to be baptized with a clear conscience. **Heb 10:22, 1 Pet 3:21**
- After baptism we receive the gift of the Ruach Hakodesh. **Acts 2:38**
- Salvation is not by water baptism alone; YHWH also requires of us.**
Believing **Acts 8:36-38**, faith **Col 2:12**, repentance **Acts 2:38**, confession of sins **Matt 3:6**, calling the name of the Lord out loud **Acts 22:16**, water **Num 19:7-9, Heb 10:22**.

12. Which statements are true about remission of sins?

- "Christ" (יהוֹשֻׁעַ) Jehoshua Hamashiach) sacrifice on the cross was for the remission of our sins. **Matt 26:28**
- We must be baptized to receive the remission for our sins. **Acts 2:38**

- The Sabbath was changed to the Lord's day and changed from Saturday to Sunday.
- The sabbath was made for man, and not man for the sabbath. **Mark 2:27**
- “Christ” (יהוֹשֻׁעַ) Jehoshua Hamashiach) mentions we will be keeping the sabbath until at least right before the great tribulation. **Matt 24:15-22**
- YHWH said that we will be keeping the sabbath even in the new heavens and the new earth. **Isa 66:22-23**
- We are commanded to keep the sabbath. **Exo 20:8-11**
- YHWH sanctified (separated) the Sabbath since creation. **Gen 2:1-3**
- The Sabbath is on the 7th day, and it is one of the 10 commandments.
- YHWH says, “It's a sign, a gift and a blessing for everyone that takes hold of His covenant. **Isa 56:2-7**
- “Christ” (יהוֹשֻׁעַ) Jehoshua Hamashiach), all the apostles including Paul and all the gentile converts kept the Sabbath. **Luke 4:16**
- YHWH and “Christ” (יהוֹשֻׁעַ) Jehoshua Hamashiach) tell us that “The sabbath is a perpetual covenant”. **Exo 31:16-17**
- There will be punishment for those who do not follow or keep the Sabbath day. **Exo 31:13-15**
- False Priests (teachers, pastors) do not keep the Sabbath. **Eze 22:26**
- In 1562 the Archbishop declared that tradition now stood above scripture and changed the sabbath from Saturday to Sunday into the Lord's day.
- Roman Emperor Constantine I issued a civil decree making Sunday a day of rest from labor.
