

  - **a.** In these next couple of pages, you will be reading verses and drawing lines connecting from one circle to the other.
  - **b.** For example: **Acts 10:43** To Him give all the prophets witness, that through His name whosoever believed in Him shall receive remission of sins. **Believing to remission of sins.**



**c.** Any verse that connects to Salvation; highlights the entire circle. For example. **John 3:16 Believe to salvation.** 




**d.** You must also highlight the lines that are commandments. Basically, the verses or lines that connect from Obedience/commandments to any other circle. For example:

Rev 5/08/2024. Pg. 6 **Map your Salvation**  The purpose of this study map is to trace the plan of salvation through Scripture, examining each verse in detail. By doing so, we gain a clearer understanding of what God requires and how each step is divinely connected to the next.

**2 Tim 2:15 (KJV)** Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.

Let's start with the most famous verse! John 3:15-17.

- **1. John 3:15 (KJV)** That whosoever believeth in him **should** not perish but have eternal life.
  - a. Believing to should have Salvation.
- **2. John 3:16 (KJV)** For YHWH so loved the world, that He gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him **should** not perish, but have everlasting life.
  - a. Believing to should have Salvation.
- **3. John 3:17 (KJV)** For YHWH sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through Him **might** be saved.
  - a. Believing to Might have Salvation.
- **4. Matt 3:2 (KJV)** And saying, Repent ye: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.
  - a. Commanded to Repent.
- **5. Matthew 3:11 (KJV)** I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance: but he that cometh after me is mightier than I, whose shoes I am not worthy to bear: he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost, and with fire:
  - a. Baptism to Holy Ghost.
- 6. Matthew 3:16 (KJV) And Christ (יהושוע Joshua Hamashiach), when He was baptized, went up straightway out of the water: and, lo, the heavens were opened unto Him, and He saw the Spirit of YHWH descending like a dove, and lighting upon him:
  - a. Baptism to Holy Ghost.
- **7. Matthew 10:22** (KJV) And ye shall be hated of all men for my name's sake: but he that endureth to the end shall be saved.
  - a. Enduring to the End to Salvation.





- **8.** Matthew 24:13 (KJV) But he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved.
  - a. Enduring to the End to Salvation.
- **9.** Mat 18:3 (KJV) And said, Verily I say unto you, Except ye be converted, and become as little children, ye shall not enter into the kingdom of heaven.
  - a. Conversion to Salvation.
- 10. Matt 28:19 (KJV) Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost:
  - a. Commandment to Baptism.
- 11. Mark 1:4 (KJV) John did baptize in the wilderness, and preach the baptism of repentance for the remission of sins.
  - a. Repentance to Baptism to Remission of sins.
- **12. Mark 1:8 (KJV)** I indeed have baptized you with water: but He shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost.
  - a. Baptism to Holy Ghost.
- 13. Mark 1:10 (KJV) And straightway coming up out of the water, He saw the heavens opened, and the Spirit like a dove descending upon Him:
  - a. Baptism to Holy Ghost.
- **14. Mark 1:15 (KJV)** And saying, the time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of YHWH is at hand: repent ye, and believe the gospel.
  - a. Commands to repent.
  - b. Repentance to believing.
- 15. Mark 4:12 (KJV) That seeing they may see, and not perceive; and hearing they may hear, and not understand; lest at any time they should be converted, and their sins should be forgiven them.
  - a. Conversion to Forgiveness.
- **16. Mark 13:13 (KJV)** And ye shall be hated of all men for my name's sake: but he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved.
  - a. Enduring to the End to Salvation.
- 17. Mark 16:16 (KJV) He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.
  - a. Believing and baptism to Salvation.
  - b. Believing NOT to Death.







- **18.** Luke 1:77 (KJV) To give knowledge of salvation unto his people by the remission of their sins,
  - a. Remission to salvation.
- 19. Luke 3:3 (KJV) And he came into all the country about Jordan, preaching the baptism of repentance for the remission of sins;
  - a. Repentance to Remission of sins.
- **20.** Luke 3:16 (KJV) John answered, saying unto them all, I indeed baptize you with water; but one mightier than I cometh, the latchet of whose shoes I am not worthy to unloose: He shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost and with fire:
  - a. Baptism to Holy Ghost.
- 21. Luke 3:21-22 (KJV) Now when all the people were baptized, it came to pass, that Christ (יהושוע Joshua Hamashiach) also being baptized, and praying, the heaven was opened, And the Holy Ghost descended in a bodily shape like a dove upon Him, and a voice came from heaven, which said, Thou art my beloved Son; in thee I am well pleased.
  - a. Baptism to Holy Ghost.
- **22.** Luke 13:3 (KJV) I tell you, Nay: but, except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish.
  - a. Repentance to salvation.
- **23.** Luke 13:5 (KJV) I tell you, Nay: but, except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish.
  - a. Repentance to salvation.
- **24.** Luke 22:31-32 (KJV) And the Lord said, Simon, Simon, behold, Satan hath desired to have you, that he may sift you as wheat: But I have prayed for thee, that thy faith fail not: and when thou art converted, strengthen thy brethren
  - a. Faith to conversion.
- **25.** Luke **24:47** (KJV) And that repentance and remission of sins should be preached in his name among all nations, beginning at Jerusalem.
  - a. Commanded to repentance.
  - b. Commanded to remission of sins.



- **26. John 1:33 (KJV)** And I knew him not: but he that sent me to baptize with water, the same said unto me, Upon whom thou shalt see the Spirit descending, and remaining on him, the same is He which baptizeth with the Holy Ghost.
  - a. Baptism to Holy Ghost.
- 27. John 3:5 (KJV) Christ (יהושוע Joshua Hamashiach) answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of YHWH0.
  - a. Baptism to Salvation.
- **28. John 14:15 (KJV)** If ye love me, keep my commandments.
  - a. Love to commandments.
- **29. John 14:21 (KJV)** He that hath my commandments, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth me: and he that loveth me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him, and will manifest myself to him.
  - a. Obedience to Love.
  - b. Obedience to Father Love.
- **30. John 14:23 (KJV) Christ (יהושוע** Joshua Hamashiach) answered and said unto him, If a man love me, he will keep my words: and my Father will love him, and we will come unto him, and make our abode with him.
  - a. Love to obedience.
  - b. Obedience to Father Love.
- 31. John 20:31 (KJV) But these are written, that ye might believe that Christ (יהושוע Joshua Hamashiach) is the Christ, the Son of YHWH; and that believing ye might have life through His name.
  - a. Believing to might have Salvation.
- **32.** Acts 1:5 (KJV) For John truly baptized with water; but ye shall be baptized with the Holy Ghost not many days hence.
  - a. Baptism to Holy Ghost.
- 33. Acts 2:38 (KJV) Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Christ (יהושוע Joshua





Hamashiach) for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.

- a. Repentance and Baptism to remission of sins.
- b. Remission of sins to Holy ghost.
- **34.** Acts 3:19 (KJV) Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord.
  - a. Commands to Repent.
  - b. Repentance to conversion.
  - c. Repentance and conversion to forgiveness of sins.
- **35.** Acts 10:43 (KJV) To him give all the prophets witness, that through His name whosoever believeth in him shall receive remission of sins.
  - a. Believing to remission of sins.
- **36.** Acts 11:15-16 (KJV) Then remembered I the word of the Lord, how that He said, John indeed baptized with water; but ye shall be baptized with the Holy Ghost.
  - a. Baptism to Holy Ghost.
- 37. Act 15:11 (KJV) But we believe that through the grace of the Lord Christ (יהושוע Joshua Hamashiach) we shall be saved, even as they
  - a. Grace to Salvation.
- **38.** Acts 17:30 (KJV) And the times of this ignorance YHWH winked at; but now commandeth all men every where to repent:
  - a. Commanded to repent.
- **39.** Acts 26:18 (KJV) To open their eyes, and to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan unto YHWH, that they may receive forgiveness of sins, and inheritance among them which are sanctified by faith that is in me.
  - a. Faith to sanctification.
  - b. Sanctification to forgiveness.
- **40.** Acts 26:20 (KJV) But shewed first unto them of Damascus, and at Jerusalem, and throughout all the coasts of Judaea, and then to the





Gentiles, that they should repent and turn to YHWH, and do works meet for repentance.

- a. Repentance to works.
- **41. Romans 1:5 (KJV)** By whom we have received grace and apostleship, for obedience to the faith among all nations, for his name:
  - a. Obedience and faith to grace.
- **42. Romans 2:8–9 (KJV)** But unto them that are contentious, and do not obey the truth, but obey unrighteousness, indignation and wrath, Tribulation and anguish, upon every soul of man that doeth evil.
  - a. Disobedience to Tribulation and anguish (Death)
- 43. Romans 2:15 (KJV) Which shew the work of the law written in their hearts, their conscience also bearing witness, and their thoughts the mean while accusing or else excusing one another;)
  - a. Works with Clear Conscience (both ways).
- 44. Romans 3:22 (KJV) Even the righteousness of YHWH which is by faith of Christ (יהושוע Joshua Hamashiach) unto all and upon all them that believe: for there is no difference:
  - a. Believing to Righteousness.
- **45. Romans 3:25 (KJV)** Whom YHWH hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in His blood, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of YHWH;
  - a. Faith to propitiation/appeasement of sins.
  - b. Justification to remission of sins.
- **46. Rom 3:28 (KJV)** Therefore we conclude that a man is justified by faith without the deeds of the law.
  - a. Faith to Justification.
- 47. Rom 5:1 (KJV) Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with YHWH through our Lord Christ (אושוע Joshua Hamashiach):
  - a. Faith to Justification.
- **48. Rom 5:2** (**KJV**) By whom also we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand and rejoice in hope of the glory of YHWH.
  - a. Faith to grace.
- **49. Romans 6:16 (KJV)** Know ye not, that to whom ye yield yourselves servants to obey, his servants ye are to whom ye obey; whether of sin unto death, or of obedience unto righteousness?





- a. Obedience unto righteousness.
- b. Sin unto death.
- 50. Romans 10:9 (KJV) That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Christ (יהושוע Joshua Hamashiach), and shalt believe in thine heart that YHWH hath raised Him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.
  - a. Mouth confession and Believing to Salvation.
- **51.** Romans 10:10 (KJV) For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.
  - a. Believing to righteousness.
  - b. Confession to Salvation.
- 52. Romans 10:17 (KJV) So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of YHWH.
  - a. Hearing the word of God to Faith.
- 53. Romans 13:11 (KJV) And that, knowing the time, that now it is high time to awake out of sleep: for now, is our salvation nearer than when we believed.
  - a. Believing to nearer to Salvation.
- 54. 1 Cor 12:9 (KJV) To another faith by the same Spirit; to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit;
  - a. Holy Spirit to Faith.
- 55. Col 2:12 (KJV) Buried with him in baptism, wherein also ye are risen with him through the faith of the operation of YHWH, who hath raised Him from the dead.
  - a. Baptism to Faith.
- 56. Galatians 2:16 (KJV) Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the faith of Christ (יהושוע Joshua Hamashiach), even we have believed in Christ (יהושוע Joshua Hamashiach), that we might be justified by the faith of Christ, and not by the works of the law: for by the works of the law shall no flesh be justified.
  - a. Faith to Justification.
- 57. Gal 3:24 (KJV) Wherefore the law was our schoolmaster to bring us unto Christ, that we might be justified by faith.
  - a. Faith to Might be Justified.





- 58. Eph 1:13 (KJV) In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise,
  - a. Believing to Sealed with a promise of Salvation.
- **59. Eph 2:8 (KJV)** For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of YHWH:
  - a. Grace to Salvation.
- 60. Phil 2:11 (KJV) And that every tongue should confess that Christ (ארשוע) Joshua Hamashiach) is Lord, to the glory of YHWH the Father.
  - a. Commandment to Confess.
- 61. 1 Tim 1:5 (KJV) Now the end of the commandment is charity out of a pure heart, and of a good conscience, and of faith unfeigned:
  - a. Obedience to love (charity).
  - b. Obedience to a good conscience.
  - c. Obedience to perfect Faith.
- **62. 1 Tim 3:9 (KJV)** Holding the mystery of the faith in a pure conscience.
  - a. Pure conscience to faith.
- 63. 2 Tim 4:5 (KJV) But watch thou in all things, endure afflictions, do the work of an evangelist, make full proof of thy ministry.
  - a. Commanded to do the work of an evangelist.
- 64. Titus 2:11 (KJV) For the grace of YHWH that bringeth salvation hath appeared to all men,
  - a. Grace to salvation.
- 65. Titus 3:7 (KJV) That being justified by His grace, we should be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life.
  - a. Grace to justification.
- **66. Titus 3:8 (KJV)** This is a faithful saying, and these things I will that thou affirm constantly, that they which have believed in YHWH might be careful to maintain good works. These things are good and profitable unto men.
  - a. Believing to good works.
- 67. Hebrews 5:8–9 (KJV) Though He were a Son, yet learned He obedience by the things which He suffered; And being made perfect, He became the author of eternal salvation unto all them that obey Him.



- a. Salvation from obedience.
- **68. Hebrews 10:26–27** For if we sin wilfully after that we have received the knowledge of the truth, there remaineth no more sacrifice for sins, But a certain fearful looking for of judgment and fiery indignation, which shall devour the adversaries.
  - a. Sin (disobedience) to judgement and fiery indignation.
- **69. James 2:17 (KJV)** Even so faith, if it hath not works, is dead, being alone.
  - a. Faith to No Works to Death.
- **70. James 2:20 (KJV)** But wilt thou know, O vain man, that faith without works is dead?
  - a. Faith to No Works to Death.
- 71. James 2:22 (KJV) Seest thou how faith wrought with his works, and by works was faith made perfect?
  - a. Works to perfect faith.
- 72. James 2:24 (KJV) Ye see then how that by works a man is justified, and not by faith only.
  - a. Works to justification.
  - b. Faith to Not Justification.
- **73. James 2:26 (KJV)** For as the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without works is dead also.
  - a. Faith with no works is dead.
- 74. James 5:19-20 (KJV) Brethren, if any of you do err from the truth, and one convert him; 20 Let him know, that he which converteth the sinner from the error of his way shall save a soul from death and shall hide a multitude of sins.
  - a. Conversion to Salvation.
- 75. 1 Peter 1:9 (KJV) Receiving the end of your faith, even the salvation of your souls.
  - a. Faith to Salvation.
- 76. 1 Peter 1:5 (KJV) Who are kept by the power of YHWH through faith unto salvation ready to be revealed in the last time.
  - a. Faith to Salvation.
- 77. 1 Peter 1:14–16, 22 (KJV) As obedient children, not fashioning yourselves according to the former lusts in your ignorance... Seeing ye





have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren.

- a. Obedience to purification.
- 1 Peter 3:21 (KJV) The like figure whereunto even baptism doth also now save us (not the putting away of the filth of the flesh, but the answer of a good conscience toward YHWH,) by the resurrection of Christ (יהושוע) Joshua Hamashiach)
  - a. Baptism to Salvation.
  - b. Baptism is to good conscience.
- 79. 2 Peter 1:5-7 (KJV) And beside this, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue; and to virtue knowledge; 6 And to knowledge temperance; and to temperance patience; and to patience godliness; 7 And to godliness brotherly kindness; and to brotherly kindness charity.
  - a. Virtue, knowledge, temperance, patience, godliness, brotherly kindness, charity to Faith.
- **80.** Revelation 14:12 (KJV) Here is the patience of the saints: here are they that keep the commandments of YHWH, and the faith of Christ (יהושוע) Joshua Hamashiach).
  - a. Commandments to Salvation.
- 81. Romans 15:16 (KJV) That I should be the minister of Christ (אושוע) Joshua Hamashiach) to the Gentiles, ministering the gospel of YHWH, that the offering up of the Gentiles might be acceptable, being sanctified by the Holy Ghost.
  - a. Holy Ghost to Sanctification.
- **82. 1 Thessalonians 2:13 (KJV)** But we are bound to give thanks alway to God for you, brethren beloved of the Lord, because God hath from the beginning chosen you to salvation through sanctification of the Spirit and belief of the truth:
  - a. Sanctification and belief to Salvation.
- **83. 2 Thessalonians 1:7–9 (KJV)** The Lord Jesus shall be revealed from heaven with His mighty angels, In flaming fire taking vengeance on them that know not God, and that obey not the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ.
  - a. Disobedience to flaming fire (Hell)







- **84. Eph 4:30 (KJV)** And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.
  - a. Sealed (with the promise of salvation) until Salvation.
- **85. Deuteronomy 11:26–28 (KJV)** Behold, I set before you this day a blessing and a curse; A blessing, if ye obey the commandments of the Lord your God...And a curse, if ye will not obey the commandments of the Lord your God.
  - a. Obedience to blessing.
  - b. Disobedience to curse.

Remember this truth. God has only one way, one truth, and one plan of salvation. Satan has corrupted and counterfeited nearly everything that belongs to God. He has built false paths that look right but lead to destruction. He offers a fake Christ (יהושוע), a fake Holy Spirit (Ruach Hakodesh), and a fake gospel that many follow without realizing it. If you are not walking in the exact way that God has commanded for salvation, you will not enter His kingdom.

Luke 13:23-24 (KJV) Then said one unto him, Lord, are there few that be saved? And he said unto them, Strive to enter in at the strait gate: for many, I say unto you, will seek to enter in, and shall not be able.

The doctrine of the apostles is a direct teaching of our Lord and Saviour Christ (יהושוע Joshua Hamashiach) in connection to eternal life.

Hamashiach taught the apostles the doctrine of YHWH the Father. Mark 4:2 (KJV) And he taught them many things by parables, and said unto them in his doctrine,

Anything different are the doctrines of devils.

Matthew 7:21 (KJV) Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.
