- ✓ YHWH sanctified (separated) the Sabbath since creation. Gen 2:1-3
- \blacksquare The Sabbath is on the 7th day, and it is one of the 10 commandments.
- ☑ YHWH says, "It's a sign, a gift and a blessing for everyone that takes hold of His covenant. Isa 56:2-7
- ✓ "Jesus" (יהושוע" Joshua Hamashiach), all the apostles including Paul and all the gentile converts kept the Sabbath.
 Luke 4:16
- ✓ YHWH and "Jesus" (יהושוע Joshua Hamashiach) tell us that "The sabbath is a perpetual covenant". Exo 31:16-17
- ✓ There will be punishment for those who do not follow or keep the Sabbath day. Exo 31:13-15
- ☑ False Priests (teachers, pastors) do not keep the Sabbath. Eze 22:26
- ☑ In 1562 the Archbishop declared that tradition now stood above scripture and changed the sabbath from Saturday to Sunday into the Lord's day.
- ☑ Roman Emperor Constantine I issued a civil decree making Sunday a day of rest from labor.
