Disciples of "Jesus" (אושוע Joshua Hamashiach); teaching and continuing steadfastly in the apostle's doctrine. Acts 2:37-42

Our mission is to obediently preach the Gospel of Christ through the Apostle's doctrine. Preaching the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation which includes repentance and remission of sins.

Luke 24:47 (KJV) And that repentance and remission of sins should be preached in His name among all nations, beginning at Jerusalem.

Our Statement of Faith....

1. The word of YHWH is the sole authority for the believer's faith, conduct and doctrine. 2 Tim 3:16 (KJV) All scripture is given by inspiration of YHWH, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness:

Romans 6:12-13 (KJV) Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body, that ye should obey it in the lusts thereof. 13 Neither yield ye your members as instruments of unrighteousness unto sin: but yield yourselves unto YHWH, as those that are alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness unto YHWH.





- 2. The Old and New Testaments are verbally inspired by YHWH (and better preserved for English speaking people in the King James Version of the Bible). 2 Peter 1:20-21 (KJV) Knowing this first, that no prophecy of the scripture is of any private interpretation. 21 For the prophecy came not in old time by the will of man: but holy men of YHWH spake as they were moved by the Holy Ghost.
 - 2 Tim 3:17 (KJV) That the man of YHWH may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works.
- 3. YHWH exists as a Trinity: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. John 1:1-3 (KJV) In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with YHWH, and the Word was God. 2 The same was in the beginning with YHWH. 3 All things were made by him; and without him was not anything made that was made.

1 John 5:7 (KJV) For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one.

John 10:30 (KJV) I and my Father are one.

- 4. The world was created by YHWH through Christ in six literal twenty-four-hour days. (Genesis 1)
- 5. All mankind is sinful after the fall of Adam, and all mankind needs salvation. Rom. 5:12 (KJV) Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned:





6. In the virgin birth, sinless life of "Jesus" (הושוע Joshua Hamashiach), and that He died for the sins of all those that would believe in Him.

(Matt 1:18-25 (KJV) Now the birth of "Jesus" (סרושוע) Joshua Hamashiach) Christ was on this wise: When as His mother Mary was espoused to Joseph, before they came together, she was found with child of the Holy Ghost. 19 Then Joseph her husband, being a just man, and not willing to make her a public example, was minded to put her away privily. 20 But while he thought on these things, behold, the angel of the Lord appeared unto him in a dream, saying, Joseph, thou son of David, fear not to take unto thee Mary thy wife: for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Ghost. 21 And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call His name "Jesus" (יהושוע Joshua Hamashiach): for He shall save His people from their sins. 22 Now all this was done, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken of the Lord by the prophet, saying, 23 Behold, a virgin shall be with child, and shall bring forth a son, and they shall call His name Emmanuel, which being interpreted is, God with us. 24 Then Joseph being raised from sleep did as the angel of the Lord had bidden him and took unto him his wife: 25 And knew her not till she had brought forth her firstborn son: and he called His name "Jesus" (סהושוע Joshua Hamashiach).

Hebrews 10:10 (KJV) By the which will we are sanctified through the offering of the body of "Jesus" (יהושוע" Joshua Hamashiach) Chist once for all.

7. In the literal, bodily resurrection of Christ from the grave and bodily ascension into Heaven where He is seated at the right hand of the Father interceding for believers. 1 Corinthians 15:4 (KJV) And that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the scriptures:

Rom. 8:34 (KJV) Who is he that condemneth? It is Christ that died, yea rather, that is risen again, who is even at the right hand of YHWH, who also maketh intercession for us.

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- 8. In a literal Heaven and a literal Hell as the only two eternal abodes of the souls of men. John 14:2-3 (KJV) In my Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. 3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also.

 2 Peter 2:4 (KJV) For if YHWH spared not the angels that sinned, but cast them down to hell, and delivered them into chains of darkness, to be reserved unto judgment;
- 9. In the autonomy of the local church as an assembly of baptized believers (disciples) with the purpose of carrying out the Great Commission. (Matt 28:19 (KJV) Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost:

Acts 2:37-42 (KJV) Now when they heard this, they were pricked in their heart, and said unto Peter and to the rest of the apostles, Men and brethren, what shall we do? 38 Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of "Jesus" (סלום Joshua Hamashiach) Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. 39 For the promise is unto you, and to your children, and to all that are afar off, even as many as the Lord our God shall call. 40 And with many other words did He testify and exhort, saying, Save yourselves from this untoward generation. 41 Then they that gladly received His word were baptized: and the same day there were added unto them about three thousand souls. 42 And they continued stedfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, and in breaking of bread, and in prayers.



10. That those that believe and have put their faith in Christ's finished work on the cross and fulfill all of YHWH's conditions (requirements) for salvation will abide with YHWH in Heaven for eternity. (1 John 5:12 (KJV) He that hath the Son hath life; and he that hath not the Son of YHWH hath not life.

The conditions/requirements are as follow:

- a. By believing which is the first step towards salvation and that no one is saved the moment they believe. Romans 13:11 And that, knowing the time, that now it is high time to awake out of sleep: for now is our salvation nearer than when we believed.
- b. That the moment a person believes, they are sealed with YHWH's promise of salvation until the day of their salvation. We understand that it is only a promise and not salvation! And that "if" and "as long as" that person meets all the conditions/requirements that YHWH has, in order to give them that salvation, that person will receive that salvation!
 - * Gal 3:22 (KJV) But the scripture hath concluded all under sin, that the promise by faith of "Jesus" (סהושוע") Joshua Hamashiach) Christ might be given to them that believe.

1 John 2:25 (KJV) And this is the promise that he hath promised us, even eternal life.

Ephesians 1:13-14 (KJV) In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise, Which is the earnest of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, unto the praise of His glory.



Ephesians 4:30 (KJV) And grieve not the holy Spirit of YHWH, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.
Also in 1 Peter 18-25, Mark 16:16, Romans 10:9, Acts 16:31, John 3:16, 1 Corinthians 15:4)

- c. By Faith. Ephesians 2:8 (KJV) For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of YHWH:
 2 Timothy 3:15 (KJV) And that from a child thou hast known the holy scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in "Jesus" (אושוע) Joshua Hamashiach) Christ.
 - 1 Peter 1:5 (KJV) Who are kept by the power of YHWH through faith unto salvation ready to be revealed in the last time.
- d. By recognizing that we have sinned against YHWH and broke His commandments. Romans 3:23 (KJV) For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of YHWH.
- e. By being willing to turn from our sins and repent. 2 Peter 3:9 (KJV) The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.

Mark 2:17 (KJV) When "Jesus" (יהושוע Joshua Hamashiach) heard it, He saith unto them, They that are whole have no need of the physician, but they that are sick: I came not to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance.

Acts 2:38 (KJV) Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of "Jesus" (סוגשונע Joshua Hamashiach) Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.





f. By confessing with our mouth (Audible) "Jesus" (סהושוע") Joshua Hamashiach) Lord and Saviour. Acts 2:21 (KJV) And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved.

Romans 10:9-13 (KJV) That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord "Jesus" (הושוע" Joshua Hamashiach), and shalt believe in thine heart that YHWH hath raised Him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. 10 For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. 11 For the scripture saith, Whosoever believeth on Him shall not be ashamed. 12 For there is no difference between the Jew and the Greek: for the same Lord over all is rich unto all that call upon Him. 13 For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.

g. By baptism. Baptism is NOT an outward expression of our faith! And baptism is NOT just done out of obedience! Baptism is an essential part of salvation!

Romans 6:3-4 (KJV) Know ye not, that so many of us as were baptized into "Jesus" (יהושוע" Joshua Hamashiach) Christ were baptized into his death? Therefore, we are buried with Him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.

Galatians 3:26-27 (KJV) For ye are all the children of YHWH by faith in "Jesus" (יהושוע Joshua Hamashiach) Christ. 27 For as many of you as have been baptized into Christ have put on Christ.

Baptism and with water because it is "physical water" what YHWH chose to use as a physical instrument for our spiritual purification of our sins. Num 19:7-9 (KJV) ... "for a water of separation: it is a purification for sin." Exo 30:20 (KJV) "they shall wash with water, that they die not;"

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Lev 22:6 (KJV) "shall be unclean until even, unless he wash his flesh with water."

John 3:5 (KJV) "Jesus" (יהושוע Joshua Hamashiach) answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of YHWH.

Matt 3:6 (KJV) And were baptized of him in Jordan, confessing their sins.

Acts 8:38 And he commanded the chariot to stand still: and they went down both into the water, both Philip and the eunuch; and he baptized him.

- i. Baptism must be done in the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy Ghost (using their known Hebrew names).
 Matthew 28:19 (KJV) Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost:
- ii. By one Water Baptism that is done for both, the remission of sins and for the indwelling of the Holy Ghost. Ephesians 4:5 (KJV) One Lord, one faith, one baptism,
- iii. Water baptism must be done for the purpose of the remission of sins Acts 2:38 (KJV) Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of "Jesus" (הושוע" Joshua Hamashiach) Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.

 Luke 3:3 (KJV) And he came into all the country about Jordan, preaching the baptism of repentance for the remission of sins.
- iv. Water baptism must also be done for the purpose of the indwelling of the Holy Ghost. Acts 19:2-5 (KJV) He said unto them, Have ye received the Holy Ghost since ye





believed? And they said unto him, We have not so much as heard whether there be any Holy Ghost. 3 And he said unto them, Unto what then were ye baptized? And they said, Unto John's baptism. 4 Then said Paul, John verily baptized with the baptism of repentance, saying unto the people, that they should believe on him which should come after him, that is, on Christ "Jesus" (אושונים) Joshua Hamashiach). 5 When they heard this, they were baptized in the name of the Lord Yeshua. Acts 1:5 (KJV) For John truly baptized with water; but ye shall be baptized with the Holy Ghost not many days hence.

Acts 11:16 (KJV) Then remembered I the word of the Lord, how that he said, John indeed baptized with water; but ye shall be baptized with the Holy Ghost.

Also found in Matt 3:16, Mark 1:10, Luke 3:22, John 1:32, Acts 8:1-40, Acts 19:2-6)

1. The praying and laying of hands after baptism for the receiving of the Holy Ghost.

Acts 8:15-17 (KJV) Who, when they were come down, prayed for them, that they might receive the Holy Ghost: 16...17 Then laid they their hands on them, and they received the Holy Ghost. 18 And when Simon saw that through laying on of the apostles' hands the Holy Ghost was given, he offered them money, 19 Saying, Give me also this power, that on whomsoever I lay hands, he may receive the Holy Ghost.

Acts 19:2-6 (KJV) 2...3...4...5...6 And when Paul had laid his hands upon them, the Holy Ghost came on them; and they spake with tongues and prophesied.







- h. That the person doing the baptism must have been called and ordained directly by YHWH or called by Him and ordained by someone who was priorly called and ordained by YHWH.
 - Acts 1:22 (KJV) Beginning from the baptism of John, unto that same day that he was taken up from us, must one be ordained to be a witness with us of His resurrection.
 - 1 Corinthians 7:17 But as YHWH hath distributed to every man, as the Lord hath called every one, so let him walk. And so, ordain I in all churches.
 - 1 Cor 9:14 (KJV) Even so hath the Lord ordained that they which preach the gospel should live of the gospel.
 - Acts 13:48 (KJV) And when the Gentiles heard this, they were glad, and glorified the word of the Lord: and as many as were ordained to eternal life believed.
- i. Why is the person performing the Baptism so important? Because the person truly called and ordained by YHWH has been given the authority to remit anyone's sins through baptism. John 20:23 (KJV) Whose soever sins ye remit, they are remitted unto them; and whose soever sins ye retain, they are retained.
- 11. By doing good works after Baptism, because YHWH commands us to, and it strengthens our faith. It also helps us maintain our salvation. Acts 26:20 (KJV) But shewed first unto them of Damascus, and at Jerusalem, and throughout all the coasts of Judaea, and then to the Gentiles, that they should repent and turn to YHWH, and do works meet for repentance.
 - a. What happens if we do not do good works?
 - *We deny professing YHWH!
 - *We are abominable (detestable) to YHWH!
 - *We are disobedient to YHWH!
 - *We are reprobates (not pure) unto every good work!







Titus 1:16 (KJV) They profess that they know YHWH; but in works they deny Him, being abominable, and disobedient, and unto every good work reprobate.

James 2:22 (KJV) Seest thou how faith wrought with his works, and by works was faith made perfect?

12. By YHWH's grace and mercy. Must look at Salvation map (Study 22) to understand why YHWH's saving grace is all the way after all the commandments, including baptism.

Acts 15:11 (KJV) But we believe that through the grace of the Lord "Jesus" (יהושוע Joshua Hamashiach) Christ we shall be saved, even as they.

Ephesians 2:8 (KJV) For by grace are ye saved **through** faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of YHWH:

Titus 2:11 (KJV) For the grace of YHWH that bringeth salvation hath appeared to all men,

Titus 3:5 (KJV) Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost;

13. As gentiles adopted by YHWH and being Yeshua's, we are now of Abraham's seed, therefore, we are of the house of Israel. We are the children of Israel.

Galatians 3:28-29 (KJV) There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither bond nor free, there is neither male nor female: for ye are all one in

"Jesus" (יהושוע Joshua Hamashiach) Christ. And if ye be Christ's, then are ye Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise.

Galatians 4:7 (KJV) Wherefore thou art no more a servant, but a son; and if a son, then an heir of YHWH through "Jesus" (סרושוע Joshua Hamashiach).

Ephesians 3:6 (KJV) That the Gentiles should be fellow heirs, and of the same body, and partakers of His promise in Yeshua by the gospel:





Romans 8:17 (KJV) And if children, then heirs; heirs of YHWH, and joint heirs with Yeshua; if so be that we suffer with Him, that we may be also glorified together.

Titus 3:7 (KJV) That being justified by His grace, we should be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life.

Hebrews 11:9 (KJV) By faith he sojourned in the land of promise, as in a strange country, dwelling in tabernacles with Isaac and Jacob, the heirs with him of the same promise:
