

Genesis 1:26-30 (KJV)

The Fall

God created the world, and the world was without evil. When Satan came into the world, evil and self-centeredness came into the world.

Genesis 1:31 (KJV)

And God saw everything that he had made, and, behold, it was very good. And the evening and the morning were the sixth day.

At the end of God's six days of creating and making all things, He placed it all under man's dominion and then pronounced it all to be "very good" (Genesis 1:26,28,31).

There was, therefore, nothing bad in that created world, no hunger, no struggle for existence, no suffering, and certainly no death of animal or human life anywhere in God's perfect creation. (plants were created as food for men and animals). There was no carnivorous activity at that time, for God had said: "And to every beast of the earth, and to every fowl of the air, and to every thing that creepeth upon the earth, wherein there is life, I have given every green herb for meat, and it was so"

Genesis 1:30 (KJV)

And to every beast of the earth, and to every fowl of the air, and to every thing that creepeth upon the earth, wherein there is life, I have given every green herb for meat: and it was so.

Adam was created without sin, but God had given him free will which gave Adam the potential to sin. At first, Adam exercised his will toward God and had fellowship with Him.

God told Adam before Eve was created that he was not to eat of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil.

Genesis 2:17 (KJV)

But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die.

Later God created Eve and even Though Adam was in the garden with Eve, the serpent ignored him completely. Instead, Eve ended up being tempted by Satan, in the form of a serpent.

Genesis 3:1 (KJV)

Now the serpent was more subtil than any beast of the field which the Lord God had made. And he said unto the woman, Yea, hath God said, Ye shall not eat of every tree of the garden?

Satan begins the temptation with a question, "Hath God said Ye shall no eat of every tree of the garden?" This is the way of Satan to bring into question what God has plainly stated. It is actually bringing God Himself into question. To question God is to suggest that God could be wrong or have some sinister reason for what He says.

Eve's response was to correct Satan's question, by stating that she and Adam could eat of all the trees of the garden except the one tree called the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. It should be noted that she further stated they could not eat or "touch" it lest they die. God had said in Genesis 2:17, that they should not eat it. God did not say anything about touching it. This addition to what God had said seems to indicate that Eve resented the fact of God prohibition not to eat of that particular tree. On the other hand, it could mean that she was indicating her understanding that God did not want them to have anything to do with this tree. God said not to eat the fruit, she concluded she shouldn't even touch it. Maybe Adam, knowing eve and being more careful, told eve "don't even touch it". The fact remains eve apparently was under the impression that God had also said not to touch it.

Satan who is the father of lies, then blatantly lies, and tells Eve that she would not die!

Satan tells Eve, that God has withheld the truth from them and that if she eats the fruit of the tree, she would see the truth and they would become like gods. So now Eve deceived by Satan and desiring to be wise, eats of the fruit and Adam eats of the fruit also.

The Curse

Genesis 3:8-12 (KJV) And they heard the voice of the Lord God walking in the garden in the cool of the day: and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the Lord God amongst the trees of the garden.

- 9 And the Lord God called unto Adam, and said unto him, Where art thou? 10 And he said, I heard thy voice in the garden, and I was afraid, because I was naked; and I hid myself.
- 11 And he said, Who told thee that thou wast naked? Hast thou eaten of the tree, whereof I commanded thee that thou shouldest not eat?
- 12 And the man said, The woman whom thou gavest to be with me, she gave me of the tree, and I did eat.

We do not really know if Eve ate the fruit and later gave Adam to eat from it, or they both ate it at the same time, but Adam listened to his wife and allowed her to convince him to be disobedient to God.

The original sin was disobedience to God.

It was the death of their innocence. The beginning of sin in their lives. Now they know evil.

Then God said to Adam, "Because you have listened to the voice of your wife and have eaten from the tree about which I commanded you, saying, 'You shall not eat from it'; Cursed is the ground because of you; In toil you shall eat of it All the days of your life. "Both thorns and thistles it shall grow for you; and you shall eat the plants of the field;

Genesis 3:16-18 (KJV) Unto the woman he said, I will greatly multiply thy sorrow and thy conception; in sorrow thou shalt bring forth children; and thy desire shall be to thy husband, and he shall rule over thee.17 And unto Adam he said, Because thou hast hearkened unto the voice of thy wife, and hast eaten of the tree, of which I commanded thee, saying, Thou shalt not eat of it: cursed is the ground for thy sake; in sorrow shalt thou eat of it all the days of thy life;

- 18 Thorns also and thistles shall it bring forth to thee; and thou shalt eat the herb of the field;
- 19 In the sweat of thy face shalt thou eat bread, till thou return unto the ground; for out of it wast thou taken: for dust thou art, and unto dust shalt thou return.
- 20 And Adam called his wife's name Eve; because she was the mother of all living.
- 21 Unto Adam also and to his wife did the Lord God make coats of skins, and clothed them.
- 22 And the Lord God said, Behold, the man is become as one of us, to know good and evil: and now, lest he put forth his hand, and take also of the tree of life, and eat, and live forever:
- 23 Therefore the Lord God sent him forth from the garden of Eden, to till the ground from whence he was taken.
- 24 So he drove out the man; and he placed at the east of the garden of Eden Cherubims, and a flaming sword which turned every way, to keep the way of the tree of life.

Just as through one man sin entered into the world, and death through sin, and so sin spread through all men" (Romans 5:12). The effects of the fall are numerous and far reaching. Sin has affected every aspect of our being. It has affected our lives on earth and our eternal destiny.

Romans 5:12 (KJV) Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned:

One of the immediate effects of the Fall was that mankind was separated from God. In the Garden of Eden, Adam and Eve had perfect communion and fellowship with God. When they rebelled against Him, that fellowship was broken. They became aware of their sin and were ashamed before Him. They hid from Him (Genesis 3:8-10), and man has been hiding from God ever since.

Because of the Fall, death became a reality, and all creation was subject to it. Now, all men die, all animals die, all plant life dies. Death is an inescapable reality, and no one is immune. "For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord" (Romans 6:23).

Another effect of the Fall is that humans have lost sight of the purpose for which we were created. Man's chief end and highest purpose in life is to glorify God and enjoy Him forever.

Romans 11:36 (KJV)

36 For of him, and through him, and to him, are all things: to whom be glory forever. Amen.

1 Corinthians 6:20 (KJV)

20 For ye are bought with a price: therefore, glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.

1 Corinthians 10:31 (KJV) Whether therefore ye eat, or drink, or whatsoever ye do, do all to the glory of God.

Psalm 86:9 (KJV)

All nations whom thou hast made shall come and worship before thee, O Lord; and shall glorify thy name.

Hence, love to God is the core of all morality and goodness. The opposite is the choice of self as supreme. Selfishness is the essence of the Fall, and what follows are all other crimes against God.

In all ways sin is a turning in upon oneself, which is confirmed in how we live our lives. We call attention to ourselves and to our good qualities and accomplishments. We minimize our shortcomings. We seek special favors and opportunities in life, wanting an extra edge that no one else has. We display vigilance to our own wants and needs, while we ignore those of others. In short, we place ourselves upon the throne of our lives, usurping God's role.

When Adam chose to rebel against his Creator, Adam lost his innocence, incurred the penalty of physical and spiritual death, and his mind was darkened by sin, as are the minds of his successors.

The Fall produced in humans a state of depravity. Paul spoke of those "whose consciences are seared" (1 Timothy 4:2) and those whose minds are spiritually darkened as a result of rejecting the truth.

- 1 **Timothy 4:2 (KJV)**
- 2 Speaking lies in hypocrisy; having their conscience seared with a hot iron;

Romans 1:21 (KJV) Because that, when they knew God, they glorified him not as God, neither were thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened.

In this state, man is utterly incapable of doing or choosing that which is acceptable to God, apart from divine grace. "The sinful mind is hostile to God. It does not submit to God's law, nor can it do so" (Romans 8:7).

Romans 8:7 (KJV) Because the carnal mind is enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be.

Matthew 10:34-39 (KJV)

Think not that I am come to send peace on earth: I came not to send peace, but a sword. 35 For I am come to set a man at variance against his father, and the daughter against her mother, and the daughter in law against her mother-in-law. 36 And a man's foes shall be they of his own household. 37 He that loveth father or mother more than me is not worthy of me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me. 38 And he that taketh not his cross, and followeth after me, is not worthy of me. 39 He that findeth his life shall lose it: and he that loseth his life for my sake shall find it.

In our journey with the Lord Jesus, we will learn to understand that the Lord provides opportunities to get to know Him. He has daily words of wisdom He wants to impart to our spirit. Romans 8:22 For we know that the whole creation groaneth and travaileth in pain together until now. Because of sin, the whole creation groans, waiting for the time when Christ will return to liberate it from the effects of death.

The apostle Paul said of pagans, Romans 1:28 Since they do not think it worthwhile to retain the knowledge of God, He gave them over to a depraved mind.

He told the Corinthians 2 Corinthians 4:4 In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them.

Jesus said, "John 12:46 I am come a light into the world, that whosoever believeth on me should not abide in darkness. Paul reminded the Ephesians, **Ephesians 5:8** For ye were sometimes darkness, but now are ye light in the Lord: walk as children of light.

The purpose of salvation is Acts 26:18 To open their eyes, and to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan unto God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins, and inheritance among them which are sanctified by faith that is in Jesus Christ.

Only through Christ can that fellowship be restored, because in Him we are made as righteous and sinless in God's eyes as Adam and Eve were before they sinned. **2 Corinthians 5:21** For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.

Bottom line, without the supernatural regeneration by the Holy Spirit, all men would remain in their fallen state. But because of God's grace, mercy and loving-kindness, God sent His only begotten Son as the ultimate sacrifice to die on the cross and take the penalty of our sins, reconciling us back to Him and making eternal life with Him possible. Simply put "what was lost at the fall is reclaimed at the Cross".
