

STUDENT CODE OF CONDUCT



To support the health, safety, and wellbeing of our students as they prepare to return to campus, Student Health Advocates asks all students to follow the below Code of Conduct. Please treat yourself, others, and your environment with the same courtesy and respect that you would while living on campus.

- Follow all appropriate COVID-19 safety protocols and other guidelines listed in the “Hotel Quarantine Student Guidelines” document
- Stay on the hotel premises at all times unless otherwise directed by SHA staff or your chaperones
- Follow directions provided by your chaperones
- Follow all hotel regulations and guidance from hotel staff
- Keep your cell phone on and with you at all times and answer all calls from your school, chaperones, and SHA staff
- Treat chaperones, hotel staff, and delivery drivers with courtesy and respect
- Refrain from damaging or vandalizing hotel property
- Remain mindful of your hotel neighbors, including keeping the volume of your television and phone speakers at reasonable levels
- Refrain from using and possessing alcohol, drugs (including cannabis), and tobacco/nicotine products (including vapes), and other paraphernalia
- Remove any knives and other weapons from your possession and notify your chaperone for storage or disposal
- Store and monitor all prescription medications appropriately
- Avoid using defamatory and otherwise inappropriate language in public spaces
- Avoid any offensive behavior, conduct, or attire that may make those around you uncomfortable

While we expect that students will honor this Code of Conduct, in the event you choose to violate this Code or otherwise act inappropriately, SHA will notify your family to determine the best course of action, which could include expulsion from our program.
