## **Fundraiser Report**

The team will be embarking on new fundraisers. The Coke fundraiser will replace the Cheesecake fundraiser. Each wrestler will be asked to sell a minimum of 15 cases of coke at \$24 per case. Each case contains 24 – 20 oz. drinks. We will also consider the sale of beef jerky. This fundraiser is through Adrenaline and is \$14 for an estimate of 20 pieces. The beef jerky fundraiser will be on stand-by in the event that it is needed. If required, it is tentatively scheduled to begin in January 2020.

The Friends of Sparkman will be a continued fundraiser. Mrs. Vanessa Smallwood is working with Shortstop for T-shirts and working to obtain a new softer shirt.

Ms. Witt (Sparkman Middle Principal) sent a "Thank You" card and will also be providing a sponsorship; they will be sponsoring a wrestler. As we approach the timing to return back to school, look for information to help feeder schools. Wrestlers will also participate in the expo at Sparkman by helping to direct parents and students as to where to go.
