How do these course modalities meet Faculty and Student needs?

### Web Based

- Courses are conducted fully online
- Flexible and asynchronous
- Web-based collaboration using various technologies

### Video

- Courses are web-based
- Extensive use of digital video lectures
- Online activity, projects, or exams

### Mixed Mode

- Blended format
- Courses include both required classroom attendance and online instruction
- In-person classroom activities are more than 20% of the instructional time

### Limited Attendance

- Courses are primarily online combining required in-person and online elements
- In-person classroom activities are less than 20% of the instructional time

### Traditional Modality

- Courses meet on a regularly scheduled basis in-person
- Possible online, video, or adaptive elements are part of the instruction, thus requiring a computer

### Flexible Video

- Delivered through asynchronous online instruction (mainly video lectures)
- No regularly schedule
- Live class meetings online, as needed

### Personalized Adaptive Learning

- Course delivered via an adaptive learning system
- Customizes content and assessments for personalized learning path

### Live Online

- Course delivered through synchronous online instruction
- Class meetings online at regularly scheduled days/times
