

**Guidelines for the**  
**ST. JOHN'S UNITED CHURCH OF CHRIST, BURTON**  
**GLEN AND DOTTIE SCHOENEBOERG SCHOLARSHIP**

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*Glen and Dottie Schoeneberg were selfless leaders in both our church and community for over three decades. This scholarship is designed to award young people who have that same desire to give of their time and talents to make their future community a better, more Christian place.*

1. Be a U.S. citizen and either be a member of St. John's UCC of Burton, or attending and be a graduate candidate of Burton High School.
2. Must be a high school graduate candidate and plan to attend an accredited school of higher education or professional training after graduation.
3. The approved application must be filled out in its entirety. Applications may be obtained from the church office, the church website or Burton High School.  
Applications must include:
  - a. A 300-word essay (maximum) on the positive impact you will make as a future member of your community, much like Glen & Dottie Schoeneberg.
  - b. Three letters of recommendation.
  - c. College entrance exam scores. (Listed only, no copies needed)
  - d. A copy of your high school transcript.
4. Applications for scholarship must be received in the church office at 516 Colorado Street in Burton on or before April 1 of current year. If mailed, use address: PO Box 4, Burton, Texas 77835.
5. Scholarships must be funded within one calendar year of the application deadline.
6. An applicant awarded funding must be enrolled in a college or trade school of their choice and send proof of registration to Larry Winkelman (979-451-0888) and he will forward the award check to the institution.
7. If a recipient drops out of school before year end, the award money will be returned to St. John's United Church of Christ.
8. A 5-person committee of St. John's UCC members, approved annually by the council, will review the applications and award the scholarship funds in accordance to these guidelines.
9. The intent is to present 10 scholarships annually in the amount of \$1500 each. However, the number of scholarships awarded annually will be at the discretion of the committee and determined by the funds available, with due consideration given to St. John's UCC members as a first priority.
10. The application along with all required attachments must be complete to be considered for this scholarship.
