



# Black-Eyed-Pea Salad

### **Ingredients**

- <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> C canola oil
- 2 T red wine vinegar
- 1 T Dijon mustard
- ½ tsp salt
- ½ tsp ground black pepper
- 2 (15-ounce) cans black-eyed peas, rinsed and drained
- 1 C chopped red onion
- 1 medium red bell pepper, seeded and chopped
- 1 clove garlic, minced
- ½ cup chopped fresh parsley
- 2 T chopped fresh oregano

In a small bowl, whisk together oil, vinegar, mustard, salt, and pepper. In a large bowl, combine peas, onion, bell pepper, garlic, parsley, and oregano. Add prepared dressing and toss to coat.

### Good Luck New Year's Black-eyed Peas

# **Ingredients**

2 cans 15.5 oz. Trappey's Jalapeno Black-eyed peas – do not drain

1 med onion chopped

1 med green bell pepper chopped

2 cloves garlic, minced

2/3 C Bloody Mary mix

1 10-oz pkg frozen, cooked, salad shrimp

4 T olive oil

Put olive oil in pot. Add chopped onion, bell pepper, and garlic.

Cook until tender.

Add peas and Bloody Mary mix.

Cook to a boil on medium heat.

Cover pot. Reduce heat and simmer for 20 minutes.

Add shrimp and cook on low for 10 more minutes, uncovered.

Serve over rice—your preference: mixture of wild, brown, or white rice.
