ETNP News: Message from the Publisher

Hello Elm Thicket/Northpark Neighbors:

I hope this finds everyone no worse for the wear after those two cold blasts we had in February. It seemed like the wind was blowing right into my bones. But spring is upon us and it will be nice to be outside to enjoy the sun and pleasant weather.

Coming out of our hibernations, there are a couple of spring cleaning reminders we want to share with you.

The most important one is to make sure you are registered to vote. We have city council elections this May. The elected officials who will have the most direct impact on us and our beloved neighborhood are the folks we put around the horn at city hall. So if you are not registered please remedy that as soon as possible.

The next reminder is to change the batteries in your smoke alarms and carbon monoxide detectors. Daylight Savings is this coming weekend, March 9. So when you set clocks ahead an hour, take a couple of minutes to change those batteries.

The third reminder concerns spring cleaning and city services. Our code enforcement officer attended the crime watch meeting in February and made a point to remind everyone of when to put out heavy trash for pick up.

In Elm Thicket/Northpark, heavy trash pick up is during the first full week of the month. So for March, it would be this week. You can start setting out items for heavy trash pick up the weekend before pick up. If you set it out before that weekend or after pick up you run the risk of getting a citation that can be a couple of hundred

dollars. Code will not issue warning letters for setting your heavy trash out too early or too late. Also, the amount of heavy trash you set out needs to be able to fit into a 10-foot by 10-foot by 10-foot space.

For new Ellum Thicket neighbors who are first time homeowners, code enforcement said we are all responsible for the maintenance of our yards from the front curb of our homes to half of the alley. So if you like doing your own yardwork or if you hire someone please remember to cut the growth in the alley and keep it clear. Code Enforcement is currently doing alley sweeps and those with overgrown alleys will receive a courtesy letter asking them to clear the issue. You'll have time to get the alley cleared before they re-inspect. The courtesy letter will have the name and number of the code enforcement officer if you have questions so please do not hesitate to contact them.

The last reminder is to please mark your calendars for upcoming events in the Elm Thicket/Northpark neighborhood. The K. B. Polk Recreation Center will be hopping with Spring Break Camp, T-Ball, an Easter Egg Hunt, and the big Mother's Day Party for the ETNP seniors. If you've thought about getting more information on the Active Senior Adult Program this will be a perfect opportunity to do so.

So with that my neighbors, I sign off so you can read the rest of the newsletter. Here's hoping you and yours have a wonderful month of March.

Code Enforcement Performing Alley Sweeps in Elm Thicket

During the February crime watch meeting, a code enforcement representative said the department is currently performing alley sweeps in our neighborhood. When doing alley sweeps, the code enforcement officers look for overgrown vegetation or vegetation that makes it hard to get through the alley. Homeowners are responsible for keeping their grass and vegetation mowed from the front curb all the way to the middle of the alley.

The representative said those homes with overgrown alleys, will get a "courtesy letter" asking them to mow and clean their alley. He said code officers will knock on the homeowners door and explain what needs to be done.


After two weeks, code enforcement will return to re-inspect and if the alley has not been addressed then an inspector with code enforcement will contact the homeowner and notify them that they have an additional two weeks to remedy the situation.


Another re-inspection will take place and if at time the alley still has not been addressed then the city will issue a citation to the homeowner.

The representative said if senior citizens or physically disabled residents are unable to remedy the situation, they should contact the code enforcement officer or inspector and see what programs the city has to help. The name and number of the code enforcement officer will be on the notice they leave for you.

Register to Vote by April 3 for May 3 Election

Thursday, April 3, is the last day to register to vote in the May 3 Dallas city council election. To check your registration status, go to www.dallascountyvotes.org/voters/registration/status/#VoterEligibilitySearch to verify your status. If you are not registered, you will need to fill out a voter registration card (click here) and mail it in. You can, however, deliver it in person to the Dallas County Elections Department. Fortunately for us, this office is about 10 minutes away from the K.B. Polk Rec Center at 1520 Round Table Dr., Dallas, TX 75247 (see map below). The office is open weekdays from 8:00am to 4:30pm.






