

ETNP News: Message from the Publisher

Hello ETNP News Readers:

Save Elm Thicket was created and exists to protect and preserve the legacy of this historic freedmen's community we all love and call home. As we did in the November general election, Save Elm Thicket through its publication the ETNP News, we will be endorsing a candidate for City Council District 2 and District 6 in the upcoming Dallas election set for May 3, 2025.

In the council race for District 2, which is boarded by University Boulevard, Lemmon Avenue, Mockingbird Lane and Inwood Road, we are endorsing incumbent Jesse Moreno. Councilman Moreno is the proven leader we need to help us continue to preserve the history of our neighborhood and help us fight the good fights.

Councilman Moreno has a long history with the Elm Thicket/Northpark neighborhood. Before being elected to his first term in office in 2021, he served on the District 2 Park Board and was the force behind getting us the Thedford Spray Park next to the K. B. Polk Rec Center. That spray park was a huge quality of life improvement for everyone who lives in our neighborhood.

More importantly, however, Councilman Moreno's support for the neighborhood zoning case he inherited from his predecessor has earned him another term. Councilman Moreno and his staff made a point to listen to every voice. Councilman Moreno spearheaded the effort to have the city council unanimously pass the zoning case which restricted the height, roof type and lot coverage for new homes constructed in Ellum Thicket. This cemented the neighborhood protections that we fought to put in place since 2016.



More importantly, however, Councilman Moreno's support for the neighborhood zoning case he inherited from his predecessor has earned him another term. Councilman Moreno and his staff made a point to listen to every voice. Councilman Moreno spearheaded the effort to have the city council unanimously pass the zoning case which restricted the height, roof type and lot coverage for new homes constructed in Ellum Thicket. This cemented the neighborhood protections that we fought to put in place since 2016.

Jesse's only opponent responded well to the question that was published in our April edition of ETNP News; however, Councilman Moreno has visited our neighborhood more times than we can count to hear from his constituents. He knows our neighborhood.

The District 6 council position, which is bordered in Elm Thicket/Northpark, by University Boulevard, Lovers Lane, Lemmon Avenue and Inwood Road, is the most contested race in the City of Dallas. We are grateful to all the candidates who chose to run. It makes for a stronger republic when we have options. We can only endorse one candidate, however, and that candidate is Laura Cadena.

From the moment the northside of Elm Thicket/Northpark became a part of District 6 after redistricting, Ms. Cadena made a point to attend crime watch meetings, neighborhood events and be a liaison between the Councilman Narvaez's office and our neighborhood. As the chief of staff for Councilman Narvaez, Ms. Cadena learned the concerns of our residents. She made a point to learn where the northside of the Ellum Thicket lacked curb cuts. It may not seem like a big issue, but for residents who need them it is a quality of life issue and that is what is needed in the elected officials that represent our neighborhood. We fully anticipate Ms. Cadena will continue to be a visible leader at our community events and meetings.

We liked hearing from some of the other District 6 candidates when we asked them to respond to the question "If elected to the Dallas city council, what is one thing you would do to help preserve and protect the character and legacy of our historic freedman's community of Ellum Thicket for future generations?" Those responses were published in our <u>April edition of ETNP News</u>.



Curbside Voting an Option for Disabled Voters

Curbside Voting Service is available during Early Voting and Election Day to any voter who is physically unable to enter the polling place without personal assistance or has a likelihood of injury if they attempt to enter the polling place.

If you have an assistant with you, have them notify the election official when you arrive at the polling location. The election official will then bring everything you need to your vehicle outside the polling location. If you do not have an assistant, please call 469-627-8683 ahead of time to notify the Election Day clerk that you want to vote



If you cannot enter the polling location without assistance or there is a risk of injury if you do, you can vote from your vehicle. An election worker will bring you a ballot and the polling machine right to you.

curbside. A physical limitation should never stop someone from casting their vote.

Votación en la Acera: Una Opción para Votantes con Discapacidad

El servicio de votación en la acera está disponible durante la votación anticipada y el día de las elecciones para cualquier votante que no pueda ingresar al centro de votación sin asistencia personal o que corra el riesgo de lesionarse si intenta ingresar.

Si tiene un asistente, pídale que notifique al funcionario electoral cuando llegue al centro de votación. El funcionario electoral le llevará todo lo necesario a su vehículo, ubicado afuera del centro de votación. Si no tiene un asistente, llame al 469-627-8683 con anticipación para notificar al secretario del día de las elecciones que desea votar en la acera. Una limitación física nunca debe impedir que alguien emita su voto.




Know Your ID Requirements to Vote on Election Day

Be sure you bring the appropriate identification to vote on Election Day to ensure you vote is counted.

If you're aged 18-69, the ID should be current or can be expired for up to four years. If you're 70 or older, your ID can be expired for any length of time but must still be otherwise valid.

If you cannot present one of the forms of ID above and have a valid reason, you can use a supporting form of ID from <u>List</u> <u>B</u> and execute a Reasonable Impediment Declaration.



For voters who were unable to present a photo ID and had to vote provisionally on Election Day, they have until Friday, May 9, to <u>cure</u> their ballot.

Conozca los Requisitos de Identificación para Votar el día de las Elecciones

Asegúrese de traer la identificación válida para votar el día de las elecciones y así garantizar que su voto sea contabilizado.

Si tiene entre 18 y 69 años, la identificación debe estar vigente o puede tener una vigencia de hasta cuatro años. Si tiene 70 años o más, su identificación puede tener una vigencia de cualquier período, pero debe seguir siendo válida.

Los votantes que no pudieron presentar una identificación con fotografía y tuvieron que votar provisionalmente el día de la elección, tienen hasta el viernes 9 de mayo para "<u>corregir</u>" su boleta.
