Regular Council Meeting
JUNE 18TH, 2025

The meeting was brought to order by Mayor Craig Everett and the pledge of allegiance was said. Roll call was read: Gross absent, Vandersall present, Wildman present, Boyer present, Lee absent, and Young absent. Young moved and Boyer second to approve the minutes as corrected. All yeah, M/C. Boyer moved and Wildman second to turn all bills over to finance and to pay all those found favorable. All yeah, M/C.

Mayor reported that Joe & Terry have been working on the front ball diamond fencing. The back ball diamond fencing is all done, repaired, and the blue tile is up. Will install the new tile on the front field once finished with repairs and painting.

Fiscal Officer reported an update for Sanitary Sewer Project. Brian spoke with Joe and looking to order a Badger brand flowmeter to get the project completed. So, still having issues on getting the original. Young moved and Wildman second to pass Resolution 6-25-758: Amending 2025 Appropriations for payroll General Fund, building, and Sewer Capital Fund. Fire Chief John Houtz approved Eagleville Joint Ambulance District to join Wood County Mutual Aid. Mayor Everett has not a chance to look into the ODOT grants yet.

Fiscal Officer mentioned that Gross wanted street sweeping quote put on the agenda. Council is going to table for now. Council discussed July 2nd meeting and decided to cancel due to the holiday and members that might not be available. Fiscal Officer passed out and went over a quote from Text My Gov. Council went thru, discussed, and decided not to proceed since the village already has the Code Red alerts. Mayor reported that BGSU is in town trapping for mosquito's this year again.
