Regular Council Meeting
MARCH 4TH, 2026

The meeting was brought to order by Mayor Craig Everett and the pledge of allegiance was said. Roll call was read: Gross present, Vandersall present, Wildman present, Boyer present, Lee present, and Young present. Young moved and Vandersall second to approve the minutes as read. All yeah, M/C. Gross reported the transmitter was received by Sparling, just waiting on repair and when will be sent back. Had 2nd reading Ordinance 3-26-762: 2026 Permanent Appropriations \$802,702. Gross moved and Young second to approve the Rules of Council for 2026. All yeah, M/C.

Fiscal Officer based around the bid from Erie Mowers on mowing the lagoon and maintain the bank for 2026. Gross moved and Lee second to accept the bid for 2026 from Erie Mowers. All yeah, M/C. Fiscal Officer received the new quote for the Medical Ins. renewal at 9.27%. Fiscal Officer will forward the renewal to the Administrative Committee for review. Mayor and Wildman brought up some ideas about adding a water/sewer tab to the website for information and link to bill pay, maybe a welcome packet for new residents, etc. Wildman and Fiscal Officer will work together and see what they can come up with.
