

Village of Wayne
Regular Council Meeting
MARCH 18TH, 2026

The meeting was brought to order by Mayor Craig Everett and the pledge of allegiance was said. Roll call was read: Gross present, Vandersall present, Wildman present, Boyer present, Lee present, and Young present. Wildman moved and Vandersall second to approve the minutes as read. All yeah, M/C. Vandersall moved and Lee second to turn all bills over to finance and to pay all those found favorable. All yeah, M/C.

Elmwood Youth League met with council and discussed the ballpark use, what was added to the memorandum, etc. Council would like quarterly reports and a copy of the insurance. Wayne's representative and a couple members of council will get together and do a walk through and sign agreement.
