Regular Council Meeting  
FEBRUARY 4<sup>TH</sup>, 2026

The meeting was brought to order by Mayor Craig Everett and the pledge of allegiance was said. Roll call was read: Gross present, Vandersall present, Wildman present, Boyer absent, Lee present, and Young present. Young moved and Lee second to approve the minutes as read. All yeah, M/C. Police Chief Todd Mocniak reported that the cruiser was paid off in Jan. 2026. The automated/electronic ticket has been installed and working in the cruiser. Just waiting on CAD from the Sheriff Dept. and working on a glitch on the wifi router in the cruiser.

Wildman spoke with solicitor on the Little League memorandum with adding about the scoreboard, etc. Vandersall mentioned appreciated Terry and Luke clearing the snow out away from the fire hydrants.

Mayor reported that a resident, Paul Wisner, filed a complaint to the EPA about the water. EPA discussed with the resident the difference with surface water to well water, Wayne uses gas chlorine, regularly tests and is compliance with EPA regulations, etc. Mayor just wanted Council to know about a complaint filed.

Fiscal Officer reported heard from Choice One on the flowmeter. Gross discussed the two options that Choice One sent over: 1<sup>st</sup> Geo Gradel can retrieve and send back the transmitter to get fixed (warranty) or 2<sup>nd</sup> purchase a whole new flowmeter out the village funds. Council approved to go with option 1 to have the transmitter sent back and covered under warranty. Gross will email Choice One with the discission Council has made.

No further business, Wildman moved and Young second to adjourn. All yeah, M/C.
