Regular Council Meeting  
JANUARY 7<sup>TH</sup>, 2026

The meeting was brought to order by Mayor Craig Everett and the pledge of allegiance was said. Roll call was read: Gross present, Vandersall present, Wildman present, Boyer present, Lee present, and Young present. Young moved and Lee second to approve the minutes as corrected. All yeah, M/C. Fiscal Officer reported that the flowmeter is currently not working and throwing an error code. Geo Gradel is reaching out to the company to figure out the issue. Fiscal Officer has spoken with Brian at Choice One with some issues on the flowmeter. Gross will follow up with a couple others from Choice One.

Vandersall moved Lee second to approve the financial report for November 30, 2025. All yeah, M/C. Council reviewed and everyone agreed to keep the same Board members for the Fire Fighter's Dependent Fund for 2026. Fiscal Officer will update. Mayor opened nominations for council president. Lee moved and Vandersall second to nominate Zack Boyer. All yeah, M/C. Mayor closed nominations. Boyer accepted the position of Council President for 2026.

Young discussed that wanted to promote Halloween early this year and try to make it bigger. Thinking food trucks, bouncy houses, etc.

No further business, Young moved and Gross second to adjourn. All yeah, M/C.
