

**Village of Wayne**  
Regular Council Meeting  
JUNE 3<sup>RD</sup>, 2026

The meeting was brought to order by Mayor Craig Everett and the pledge of allegiance was said. Roll call was read: Gross present, Vandersall present, Wildman present, Boyer present, Lee present, and Young present. Young moved and Boyer second to approve the minutes as read. All yeah, M/C. Young moved and Lee second to turn all bills over to finance and to pay all those found favorable. All yeah, M/C.

Police Chief, Todd Mocniak, reported got background check back on the one application and just need to verify if got permission from his current employment to work outside the sheriff sept. Mayor also spoke of the applicant. Council and Police Chief spoke about the electric bikes. Children/adults have to obey all traffic rules when operating an electric bike. Stop at stop signs, turn signals, etc.

This is becoming another issue with the supplier Sparling. Gross will get in contact with the village solicitor to see what can be done. Fiscal Officer reported that the new owner of the property at the end of Bryant was parking his vehicle inside the garage that is owned by the village going to be teared down. Fiscal Officer contacted the solicitor to see what the next step was (letter taped to door). Sergeant stopped by to inform the resident but was not home at the time however, the Police Chief was able to give him the letter form the village this evening.

Mayor reported about the issues with the current to Grasshopper mowers. Village Administrator, Joe St Clair, went and got a quote for a new X-Mark mower from Shank's. With trading in the two Grasshopper mowers, they new 2026 model X-Mark would be \$3,199.00. Gross moved and Young second to purchase the new mower, trading in the two Grasshopper's from Shank's for \$3,199.00. All yeah, M/C. Joe mentioned water damage, rotting wood, etc. on the back of the office building. Fiscal Officer had pictures for council to look at. Joe got an estimate from Win Construction on the repairs totaling (on the high end) around \$18,750.00. Gross moved and Vandersall second to approve Win Construction to repair the water damage at \$18,750.00. All yeah, M/C.

Fiscal Officer handed out the 2027 Estimated Revenues for review before turning in the county auditor. Gross moved and Vandersall second to approve the 2027 Estimated Revenues. All yeah, M/C. Fiscal Officer brought up about a free library from Kristi at the Wayne Public Library. Kristi was wondering if could put a free library in the park and she would check on it, add books, etc. when changed the story book in the park. Council would like see the plans for the library box, etc. and who is going to maintain the box if vandalism, books destroyed and scattered around the park, etc. Fiscal Officer will get back to Kristi with the request.

No further business, Gross moved and Boyer second to adjourn. All yeah, M/C.
