Regular Council Meeting
JUNE 4TH, 2025

The meeting was brought to order by Mayor Craig Everett and the pledge of allegiance was said. Roll call was read: Gross present, Vandersall present, Wildman present, Boyer present, Lee present, and Young absent. Lee moved and Vandersall second to approve the minutes as corrected. All yeah, M/C. Vandersall moved and Lee second to turn all bills over to finance and to pay all those found favorable. All yeah, M/C.

Mike Bechstein activated his water account on 5/7/25 during the 4/21/25 to 5/23/25 billing cycle. Mr. Bechstein would like his water bill prorated since did not turn water on until 5/7/25. Council will need to discuss with solicitor: Make an acceptance for a new structure because did not have water for half the billing cycle?, What is included in the tap fees in other towns?, etc. Vandersall mentioned currently to pay bill in full to avoid late fee penalty until can speak with solicitor. Bechstein also mentioned about changing his shop address to 100 or 102 Railroad St instead of 200 Railroad St.? Is, this something that the village is able to, correct?

Mayor reported Memorial Day Ceremony went well and Briant Lee did a great job. Mayor mentioned about how the village correct the amount that we round up for usage of water? Is round up to much? Can the village change to charging for exact usage?

Wildman reported that Farmer's Market went well. Wildman asked council if can get a quote for a similar shelter house to what is near the concession stand?

Gross moved and Vandersall second to pass Ordinance 6-25-761: No parking on west side of the street for S. Watson, Railroad, and Hutchins St. no parking is passed. All yeah, M/C. Had 2nd reading Resolution 6-25-758: Amending 2025 Appropriations for payroll General Fund, building, and Sewer Capital Fund. Little League Memorandum: All good. Mayor needs to sign and Fiscal Officer will get copies back to solicitor and Elmwood Little League.

Gross moved and Vandersall second to approve the financial report for May 31, 2025. All yeah, M/C. Fiscal Officer left a email from Jeff Klein, Wood County EMA, needs a for or against Eagleville joint Ambulance District EMS joining Wood County Mutual Aid for Fire & EMS. Council will let Fire Chief John Houtz make that decision.

No further business, Gross moved and Vandersall second to adjourn. All yeah, M/C.
