Regular Council Meeting
OCTOBER 19TH, 2022

The meeting was brought to order by Mayor Craig Everett and the pledge of allegiance was said. Roll call was read: Gross present, Lee present, Vandersall absent, Wildman present, Boyer present, and Young present. Lee moved and Boyer second to approve the minutes as read. All yeah, M/C. Lee moved and Young second to turn all bills over to finance and to pay all those found favorable. All yeah, M/C.

Gross also mentioned to have Joe and Terry weed whack the curb streets before the street sweeper comes in.

No current update on the LED street lighting as of yet. Fiscal Officer reported the new camera system for the village hall and Joe's building will start next week. Mayor discussed about getting a bathroom in Joe's building to wash hands, etc. Council asked for Joe and Terry to get a quote around for cost.
