Regular Council Meeting
OCTOBER 5TH, 2022

The meeting was brought to order by Mayor Craig Everett and the pledge of allegiance was said. Roll call was read: Gross present, Lee absent, Vandersall present, Wildman present, Boyer present, and Young present. Gross moved and Vandersall second to approve the minutes as read. All yeah, M/C.
