

Village of Wayne
Regular Council Meeting
FEBRUARY 15TH, 2023

The meeting was brought to order by Council President Andrew Gross and the pledge of allegiance was said. Roll call was read: Gross present, Lee present, Vandersall present, Wildman present, Boyer present, and Young present. Young moved and Boyer second to approve the minutes as read. All yeah, M/C. Vandersall moved and Boyer second to turn all bills over to finance and to pay all those found favorable. All yeah, M/C.

William Smith was at council to ask about a payment plan for high water bill due to a leak in which he did receive a sewer credit per village ordinance. Council and Mr. Smith spoke and council did give a few suggestions on places that might be able to help Mr. Smith out as well. Vandersall moved and Young second to waive the late fee only on this current bill (not future billings) and to set a payment plan up for \$25 (or more if can) until hear from other agencies on help, then \$200 a month for current bill only. Would have to pay bill next month plus the payment plan amount. All yeah, M/C.

Police Chief Todd Mocniak had nothing to report.

Fiscal Officer brought up that American legion in Pemberville will be hosting the Mayor's Association dinner and speaker. This year's meal is a steak dinner and takes place March 30, 2023.

No current update on the LED street lighting as of yet, Mr. Coleman waiting on an update from the team manager and has reached out to manager again a couple of days ago. Mayor and/or fiscal officer have not heard from Mr. Graf as of yet. Had 2nd reading Ordinance 3-23-744: Permanent Appropriations for 2023 totaling \$1,141,174.95.

The chain deal seems to be working to keep the recycling from blowing out and still giving people access to the bins. Solid Waste District has come out to inspect the site due to a complaint about recycling being in a residents' yard and said one of the cleanest and maintained sites they have.

Fiscal Officer went through the Fire Fighter's Dependent Fund and council replaced Mike Bechstein with Zachary Boyer and everyone else appointed last year stays the same. Fiscal Officer will fill out the form online tomorrow per requirement since state is moving to more electronic forms, etc.

No further business, Young moved and Wildman second to adjourn. All yeah, M/C.
